To whom this may concern:

I represent the above corporation. I enclose an Application For Reinstatement together with a check for \$473.75 as the reinstatement fee.

The corporation is owned by four family members and was dissolved in 1997 for failure to file annual reports with the Department of State. The officers of the corporation were unaware that it was dissolved because the pre-printed annual reports for 1997 and Notice of Dissolution was sent to a previous corporate address at 775 Longboat Key Club Drive, Longboat Key, Florida and was not forwarded on to the corporation's current address. The corporation has continued corporate activity in the interim by maintaining a bank account, filing federal and Florida intangible tax returns, managing citrus groves that it owns, etc.

The President and Vice-President, who are the primary executive officers of the corporation, are in their eighties and were unaware that the corporation was required to file annual reports with the Department of State. Accordingly, it is requested that the complete reinstatement fee of \$1,050 be waived and the reduced fee of \$465, which a representative of your department indicated was the minimal fee for reinstatement, be accepted. There is also a \$8.75 fee for certificate of status included in the check.

The officers of the corporation are aware that it is the corporate responsibility to file annual reports with the Department of State and will continue to do so from now on. They understand that this request for a waiver of the fee is a one time request that they are allowed to make. However, because the annual returns were sent to a previous address of the corporation that was no longer used and

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the form was not forwarded to the new correct address, it is requested that the reduced fee be accepted.

Please mail the Certificate of Status to my attention at the above address as soon as possible. Your cooperation is much appreciated.
