

AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

DeWoody & Co., P.A.

The undersigned incorporator, a natural person of legal age, for the purpose of forming a corporation in accordance with the Florida Business Corporation Act, Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, hereby subscribes to, acknowledges and adopts the following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation which convert DeWoody & Co., P.A. from a professional association to a business corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be DeWOODY, INC.

ARTICLE II Duration

This corporation's existence commenced on February 19,1971, and shall exist perpetual thereafter, unless sooner dissolved according to law.
