RESOLUTION - 01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BELLEAIR BEACH YACHT CLUB INCORPORATED PERTAINING TO THE DISSOLUTION OF THE CORPORATION AND TRANSFER OF ALL ASSETS AND LIABILITIES TO THE CITY OF BELLEAIR BEACH, A FLORIDA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a special meeting of the officers, directors and stockholders of the Belleair Beach Yacht Club, Inc. was held on Monday. March 5, 2001 at 444 Causeway Boulevard, in the City of Belleair Beach, Florida for the expressed purpose of considering the dissolution of the corporation and the disposition of the assets and liabilities of the corporation, with all interested persons having been properly noticed; and,

WHEREAS, all officers, directors and stockholder were present except for Directors Kaye Woolcott, Frank Lombardi and Burt Cutler; and,

WHEREAS, The officers, directors and stockholders discussed all issues associated with the possible dissolution of the corporation after being apprised as to the legal issues associated thereto by corporate legal counsel Paul J. Marino, Esquire, and having been apprised by the corporation's certified public accountant, Richard Cristini of Bollenback & Forrest P.A., regarding pertinent information relating to taxation, accounting and transfer of assets and liabilities of the corporation to a tax-exempt public entitiy,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS AND STOCKHOLDERS, INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. On a motion by Director Warde Chittenden and seconded by Vice President/Director Douglas Prescott, the officers, directors and stockholders, individually, collectively and unanimously voted that the Belleair Beach Yacht Club, Inc. be dissolve and that all of the assets and liabilities of the corporation be transferred to the City of Belleair Beach, Florida, a municipal corporation.
- Section 2. Be It Further Resolved, by officers, directors and stockholders that corporate legal counsel shall proceed with either administrative dissolution of the corporation through the Office of the Secretary of State of Florida or through a Petition filed in the Circuit Courts of Pinellas County to dissolve the corporation, transfer the assets, liabilities and to notify all creditors as required by Florida law.

Be It Further Resolved by the officers, directors and stockholders that the corporation's certified public accountant is to proceeds to prepare and file all necessary tax and information returns required by the Internal Revenue Service and any appropriate agency of the State of Florida in order to dissolve the corporation, and transfer the assets and liabilities without the imposition of any tax or special assessment thereon.
