We have received your reinstatement application; check for \$150.00 and your letter of request to have the reinstatement fee waived for your corporation. We have reviewed your documentation requesting the abatement of all fees due with the acceptance of the annual report fee for 1999. Our records reflect that the above listed corporation was dissolved December 8, 1980 for nonpayment of the 1980 annual report. Your corporation was reinstated on September 16, 1982 and returned to active status. The payment used to reinstate corporation was returned to us due to insufficient funds. Our records indicate that on November 15, 1982, a letter was forwarded to you from our fiscal Department advising you of the returned check.

On May 6, 1983, our office accepted and filed the 1983 annual report and fee in the amount of \$10.00, while the corporation remained active. However, the payment for the years 1980 to 1982 still were not made good. On April 16, 1984 your reinstatement for Kent Financial Corporation was canceled and considered not filed because of nonpayment. At that time all reports filed were to be removed from the record and the corporation returned to it's previous status (involuntarily dissolved as of December 8, 1980).Our records reflect that a letter was mailed on April 18, 1984 to the most current address on file advising of this cancellation. We have enclosed a copy of these records for your convenience.

In your documentation you indicated that your office never received notice of the cancellation returning your corporation to inactive status. You also stated that you never received any subsequent annual reports nor did you have knowledge that the corporation was required to file annual reports with the State of Florida, after your corporation had changed its address and was not actively engaged in business.

Under these circumstances our office is able to waive the reinstatement fee of \$600.00, however you will be required to pay all annual report fees due from 1980 through 1999. Therefore the total amount due to return your corporation to active status is \$1587.50. The fee amount of \$10.00 for the 1983 annual report filed by our office has been deducted from the total amount due.
