The following plan of merger is submitted in compliance with §607.1105, F.S.

ARTICLE I – SURVIVING CORPORATION

The name of the surviving corporation is CLAY OIL CORPORATION, which was formed under the laws of and is subject to the jurisdiction of Florida.

ARTICLE II – MERGING CORPORATION

The name of the merging corporations is LAKE OIL CORPORATION, which was formed under the laws of and is subject to the jurisdiction of Florida.

ARTICLE III – TERMS OF MERGER

The merger shall be effective as of December 31, 2005 (the "Effective Time"). At the Effective Time, LAKE OIL CORPORATION ("Lake Oil") shall be merged with and into CLAY OIL CORPORATION ("Clay Oil") with Clay Oil being the surviving corporation.
