RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF
EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF THE HOLY CROSS, INC. 97 (C) 7 -9 ////:47

We, the undersigned do hereby re-associate ourselves for the d_{UA} purposes of restating our articles of incorporation previously forming a corporation not-for-profit under the general laws of the State of Florida for the incorporation of religious societies, and to that end do hereby adopt and declare the following as the Restated Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLET

The name of the corporation is the EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF THE HOLY CROSS, INC., formerly known as CHURCH OF THE CROSS, INC., having been filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida on the 24th day of January, 1972.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the object of the corporation is the support of the public worship of Almighty God, according to the faith and discipline of the Episcopal Church and of the Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Southwest Florida. It acknowledges itself to be a member of and to belong to the said Church and the said Church in the Diocese of Southwest, Florida. As such it accedes to, recognizes and adopts the constitution, canons, doctrine, discipline and worship of the Episcopal Church and the constitution and canons of The Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Southwest Florida.

ARTICLE III

The members of the corporation shall all be such members of the congregation as may be qualified voters at parish elections for members of the Vestry under the canons of The Episcopal Church

regulating the subject in the Diocese of southwest Florida and said members shall be entitled to vote upon all questions which may properly come before any meeting of the congregation.

No person who shall disclaim or refuse conformity with and obedience to the constitution, canons, doctrine or worship of The Episcopal Church or of The Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Southwest Florida shall be a member of this corporation or eligible for membership therein; nor shall any such person vote for members of the Vestry or be appointed or elected a member of the Vestry, or exercise any function in, be concerned with or connected with this corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which the corporation is to exist shall be perpetual or until such time as said corporation shall have been dissolved by law.

ARTICLE VI

The officers by whom all the affairs of the corporation are to be managed shall be the Priest-In-Charge and a body of laity composed of no fewer than 5 members who shall be communicants of this corporation at least eighteen (18) years of age, and qualified voters thereof. The Priest-In-Charge shall be the Rector, and the body of laity shall be called the Vestry.

The Rector shall be elected by the Vestry subject to the approval of the Bishop of the Diocese of Southwest Florida. The Rector shall continue in office until a vacancy shall be created by resignation or death or removal, according to the canons aforesaid, and shall, when present, preside with the right to vote at all Parish meetings and at all Vestry meetings, except when the Bishop by the said canons shall have the right to preside at a Vestry meeting. The other duties and privileges of the Rector are those prescribed by the said canons.

The members of the Vestry shall be chosen by ballot at the annual meeting of the members of the corporation which shall be held on January 31st or within 90 days prior thereto in each calendar year, and in such elections a majority of votes of those members entitled to vote and present at such meeting shall be necessary to decide the choice. The Vestry shall have power to fill all vacancies which may occur in its body during the year until the next annual meeting. Of the persons chosen as members of the Vestry, one shall annually be appointed Senior Warden by the Rector and one shall annually be elected by the Vestry as Junior Warden. The Vestry shall also elect annually a Secretary and a Treasurer who need not but may be members of the The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person. The term of office of members of the Vestry may be more than one year; provided, however, that the term of office of one or more members of the Vestry shall expire each year.

Meetings of the Vestry shall be held annually on January 31 or within 90 days prior thereto of each year to receive the reports of officers and committees, to pass on the same, and to turn over the affairs of the corporation to the newly appointed or elected Vestry. Other meetings may be provided for at regular times or be called by the Rector, or in his absence by the Senior Warden, or at the request of two members of the Vestry and the Bishop of the Diocese may at his

discretion call a meeting of the Vestry and preside at such meeting. The other privileges and duties of the Vestry, the Wardens, the Secretary, and the Treasurer, shall be such as provided in the canons of The Episcopal Church and in the Diocese of Southwest Florida.

ARTICLE VII

The names of the officers who are to manage all the affairs of the corporation, until first election under these Restated Articles of Incorporation, are:

Priest-In-Charge George P. Pierce
Senior Warden/Director Patricia D. Newman
Junior Warden/Director W. Fletcher Warner
Treasurer/Director Susan F. Regan
Secretary/Director Barbara A. Warner

ARTICLE VIII

The By-Laws of the corporation (which must not be inconsistent with the canons aforesaid nor with the Articles of Incorporation) are to be made, altered or rescinded by the Vestry.

ARTICLE IX

In the event an encumbrance or alienation of real property owned by the Corporation which is not designed or used for regular services or worship shall require the consent of a majority of the whole vestry at any regular or special meeting for such purposes and the consent of the Diocesan Council. No real property held by the Corporation and designed or used for regular services or worship, whether having been consecrated or not, shall be sold, encumbered or otherwise alienated without the consent of a majority of the whole Vestry at any regular or special meeting held for such purposes nor without the consent of the Bishop acting with the advice and consent of the standing committee of the Diocese and the consent of the Diocesan Council. All conveyances

and other instruments in the name of the corporation shall be signed in the corporate name by the Priest-In-Charge, if there be one, and by the Wardens under the common seal of the corporation, the signatures of the Wardens being sufficient if there be no Priest-In-Charge.

ARTICLE X

In the case of the dissolution of the corporation, all of its property on the winding up of its affairs shall vest in the corporation known as The Diocese of Southwest Florida, Incorporated, in trust to hold and convey the same to and for some existing or future congregation, in the said city of St. Petersburg, Florida, or for members of The Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Southwest Florida, and to and for no other purposes.

ARTICLE XI

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at a meeting of the members of the corporation, duly called and convened for such purpose, and if approved by a majority of the members present and voting, the amendment shall be submitted to the Bishop and to the Diocesan Council of the Diocese, and if it be approved by them, it shall be and form part of said Articles of Incorporation upon the consequent confirmation thereof by the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE XII

RESTATEMENT

The Restatement of the Articles of Incorporation of Episcopal Church of the Holy Cross, Inc. and Amendments contained therein were duly adopted by the Vestry, acting as the directors of said corporation and approved by a majority, and a majority being sufficient for approval, of the members present and entitled to vote at a special meeting of the members of the corporation duly called and convened for the purposes of approving these Restated Articles of Incorporation on the Twenty-seventh day of July, 1997. The Restated Articles of Incorporation and Amendments contained herein were thereafter submitted to The Right Reverend Rogers S. Harris, Bishop of the Diocese of Southwest Florida and to the Diocesan Council of the Diocese of Southwest Florida and was thereafter approved by them. There exists no discrepancy between the Articles of Incorporation as heretofore amended and the provisions of these Restated Articles of Incorporation other than the inclusion of Amendments duly adopted by a meeting called for such purposes as above stated and the omission of matters of historical interest.
