The principal office and place of business and activity of the corporation shall be in the City of Jacksonville, Florida, but the corporation may have and maintain offices, camps and places of business and activity elsewhere in the state of Florida.

The general nature of the object of the corporation shall be as follows:

The proposed amended charter for the Gateway Girl Scout Council, Inc. and check for \$10 are acknowledged. The charter is being returned since there appears to be some inconsistencies with the previously filed documents. All the documents have been reviewed and we find that the amended charter must appear as a corporate act of an existing corporation, and not the act of individuals as such. We shall discuss the articles with you in this letter.

The bylaws are being returned since corporate law does not require them to be filed here. It is our understanding that the Internal Revenue Service may request a copy when the "Return" is filed.

The affidavit submitted is over the signature of a Mrs. Donald Morrison, Jr., as President. The signature is notarized by Ralph N. Pickles. In the amended charter submitted for filing a Gertrude H. Hellmuth is named President. In the last corporation report of record as of August 24, 1964 Mrs. Donald Morrison is named President. The names of the officers submitted in the amended charter are not of record as the officers named in the corporation report. The report is signed by "Mrs. Wm. S. Taylor, Jr." and she states the date of incorporation of the charter is "Feb. 1927" although the certified copy of the original charter filed here shows the date as June 9, 1932. Is it possible that there was an earlier charter of which Mrs. Taylor has knowledge?

In the absence of specific compliance to Section 617.013 (2)(f) in any of the documents filed, with the exception of the copies of record in the circuit court, we have referred to Article VIII of the amendment filed in the Circuit Court of Duval County on December 17, 1954. This article indicates that the annual meeting is held on the third Tuesday of January. In that event, new officers would probably be elected at that time.

Kindly prepare the amended charter to include a preamble stating in effect that "its issuance was duly authorized by a meeting of its members regularly called, or if its members have no voting rights, by meeting of its board of directors, managers or trustees regularly called." Kindly indicate that the organization is already a corporation not for profit. The preamble precludes the necessity of a separate certificate. (See Section 617.012(2)(line one.) An amendment or an amended charter is to be signed by the president and secretary of record in this office as the duly elected president and secretary and it should also be shown that the amendment or the amended charter was filed for the uses and purposes therein stated.

Please include the present complete address in Article I to enable the corporation to receive the report form prior to the yearly due date of July 1. In Article IV you may want to include a statement concerning the distribution of funds in the event of dissolution, since we note that the Internal Revenue is requesting many corporations to amend their charters relating to distribution of funds in the event of dissolution. You may want the Girl Scouts of the United State of America to receive the assets in the event of dissolution. An Article restating the qualification of members and the manner of their admission is necessary. Please do not include names in Articles VI and VII. Of course you may change the manner in which the corporation shall manage its affairs or elect its officers providing such change is properly authorized.

In Article V you will want to delete the names of the subscribers, since an amended charter is a corporate act and not that of a group of individuals as such. In order to show continuity of title you may name in Article V the original subscribers as they appear in the charter filed in the Duval County Circuit Court on June 9, 1932, and indicate that these are the names of these subscribers. Of course, they do not sign, since some of them may not be living. The continuity and ownership of the corporation, however, must be retained.

As you know, the original charter of this organization was Girl Scout Council of Duval County, Florida, Inc., filed in Duval County Circuit Court on June 9, 1932, and by amendment filed in the same court on December 29, 1954 changed the corporate name to Girl Scout Council of Duval County, Florida, Incorporated, and reincorporated through this office under the present corporate name of Gateway Girl Scout Council, Incorporated on May 31, 1960.

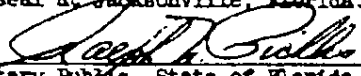

AMENDED CHARTER OF
GATEWAY GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be GATEWAY GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, INCORPORATED, with its principal office at 621 Lomax Street, Jacksonville, County of Duval, State of Florida. In the provisions of this charter and in the other affairs of the corporation, the word "council" shall be synonymous with and denote said corporate name.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the council shall be benevolent, charitable and educational, and as such it shall have all powers incident to corporations of such character, including power to erect, purchase or otherwise acquire and hold and/or dispose of real estate; and to this end the purpose of this council shall be as follows:

To help girls realize the ideals of womanhood as a preparation for their responsibilities in the home and as active citizens in the community and in the world.

To carry out the purpose and program of the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and to maintain its policies and standards.

To make the Girl Scout program available to all girls who are within the age limits recommended by the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and who live within the jurisdiction of the council.

ARTICLE III

The jurisdiction of the council shall be divided into neighborhood associations. The membership of the council shall consist of delegates elected by each neighborhood association; delegates elected by each of the standing committees of the Board; the officers and members of the Board of Directors; members of the nominating committee; and neighborhood chairman, all of whom shall be ex officio members of the council.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, provided that a charter from Girl Scouts of the United States of America is held by the corporation.

ARTICLE VII

The council shall have a Board of Directors elected by the council to whom the administrative duties of the council shall be delegated and who shall direct the affairs of the corporation. The times and the manner of the election of the Board of Directors shall be fixed by the by-laws.

ARTICLE VIII

The by-laws for the corporation shall be the by-laws as amended by the council membership at its regular meeting on October 22, 1964. They may be altered, amended or rescinded by a two-thirds vote of those present and voting at any regular meeting of the council, provided that the proposed change has been presented at a former meeting or in writing to the membership at least 10 days in advance of the meeting.

ARTICLE IX

There shall be an annual meeting of the council with the time of such meeting to be specified in the by-laws.

ARTICLE X

This charter may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those present and voting at any regular meeting of the council, provided the membership has been informed of the proposed change in writing at least 10 days prior to the date of said meeting.

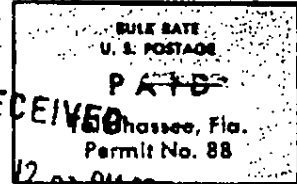

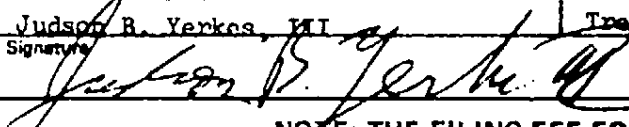

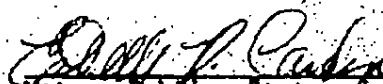

AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GATEWAY GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, INC ORPORATED

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be GATEWAY GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, INC., with its principal office at 1000 Shearer Street, Jacksonville, Duval County, State of Florida. In the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation and in the other affairs of the corporation, the word "council" shall be synonymous with and denote the corporate name.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the council shall be benevolent, charitable and educational, and as such it shall have all powers incident to corporations of such character, including power to erect, purchase or otherwise acquire and hold and/or dispose of real estate; to this end the purpose of this council shall be as follows:

(a) To help girls realize the ideals of womanhood as a preparation for their responsibilities in the home and as active citizens in the community and in the world.

(b) To carry out the purpose and program of the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and to maintain its policies and standards.

(c) To make the Girl Scout program available to all girls who are within the age limits recommended by the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and who live within the jurisdictional area of the council.

ARTICLE III

The jurisdiction of the council shall be divided into neighborhood associations. The membership of the council shall consist of delegates elected by each neighborhood association; the officers and members of the Board of Directors; members of the nominating committee; delegates to the National Council of the Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, provided that a charter from Girl Scouts of the United States of America is held by the corporation.

Election of officers shall be made at the regular meeting of the council, each three (3) years; provided, however, that a vacancy shall be filled by the Board of Directors until the next annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII

The council shall have a Board of Directors elected by the council to whom the administrative duties of the council shall be delegated and who shall direct the affairs of the corporation. The times, terms and the manner of the election of the board of directors shall be fixed by the bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

The bylaws for the corporation shall be the bylaws as amended by the council membership at its regular meeting on April 19, 1979. They may be altered, amended or rescinded by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present and voting at any regular meeting of the council, provided that the proposed change has been presented at a former meeting or in writing to the membership at least ten (10) days in advance of the meeting.

ARTICLE IX

There shall be an annual meeting of the council with the time of such meeting to be specified in the bylaws.

ARTICLE X

This charter may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present and voting at any regular meeting of the council, provided the membership has been informed of the proposed change in writing at least ten (10) days prior to the date of said meeting.

RESOLUTION AMENDING AMENDED ARTICLES
OF INCORPORATION OF GATEWAY
GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

WHEREAS a two-thirds (2/3) majority of those present and voting at the regular meeting of the Council held on the ___ day of April, 1981, deem it advisable to amend the Amended Articles of Incorporation of GATEWAY GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL, INCORPORATED, hereinafter referred to as "Council", as filed in the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida, on April 27th, 1979, in order to more faithfully express the goals of Girl Scouting and to more specifically describe the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the "Council";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

ITEM I: Article II of the Amended Articles of Incorporation of the Council, as presently constituted is revoked and repealed in its entirety, and in lieu thereof the following shall be inserted:

"ARTICLE II

"The purpose for which the Council is formed is exclusively charitable and educational as contemplated by Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax Laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, including private foundations and private operating foundations.

"The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is to offer girls residing within its jurisdiction an opportunity to participate in the Girl Scout program, in accordance with the purpose of the Girl Scout movement in the United States of America, which is to inspire girls with the highest ideals of character, conduct, patriotism, and service that they may become happy and resourceful citizens, and to that end to develop, manage, and maintain Girl Scouting throughout the area of its jurisdiction, in such manner and subject to such limitations as prescribed by the constitution, the bylaws, and the policies of Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and by the terms of the charter granted to this corporation by Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

"The Council shall have all powers reasonably necessary or incidental to further the general purposes described herein, and shall have and be authorized to exercise all powers granted to corporations not for profit by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time, including, specifically, the power to purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise

acquire, own, hold, improve, use, or otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated."

ITEM II. At the conclusion of the text of Article VII of the Amended Articles of Incorporation, as presently constituted, the following new Article shall be inserted:

"ARTICLE VIII

"(A) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

"(B) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, (except to the extent permitted by Section 501 (h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, during any fiscal year or years in which the corporation has chosen to utilize the benefits authorized by such provision), and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

"(C) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code).

"(D) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation shall not except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation."

ITEM III. At the conclusion of Article VIII as created by this Resolution of Amendment, the following article shall be inserted:

"ARTICLE IX

"Upon dissolution or liquidation of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision

for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, distribute, convey, assign or transfer all remaining property and assets of the Council to organization(s) chartered or licensed by Girl Scouts of the U.S.A., and shall be organized and operated exclusively for educational or charitable purposes as contemplated by Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended; or, such remaining assets shall be placed in trust with Girl Scouts of the U.S.A., for the benefit of Girl Scouting, pending the inclusion of the jurisdiction of the dissolved Girl Scout Council in the jurisdiction in another Girl Scout Council."

ITEM IV. Article VIII of the Amended Articles of Incorporation, as presently constituted shall be renumbered "Article X" but shall otherwise remain unamended.

ITEM V. Article IX of the Amended Articles of Incorporation, as presently constituted shall be renumbered "Article XI" but shall otherwise remain unamended.

ITEM VI. Article X of the Amended Articles of Incorporation, as presently constituted shall be renumbered "Article XII" but shall otherwise remain unamended.

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617.02 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation, not for profit, which originally received its charter by order of Circuit Court of the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Duval County, Florida, dated the ninth day of June, A.D., 1932 and in accordance with its bylaws and the law, having amended their original Articles of Incorporation and adopted the following restated Articles of Incorporation.

The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is to offer girls residing within its jurisdiction an opportunity to participate in the Girl Scout program, in accordance with the purpose of the Girl Scout movement in the United States of America, which is to inspire girls with the highest ideals of character, conduct, patriotism, and service that they may become happy and resourceful citizens, and to that end to develop, manage, and maintain Girl Scouting throughout the area of its jurisdiction, in such manner and subject to such limitations as prescribed by the constitution, the bylaws, and the policies of Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and by the terms of the charter granted to this corporation by Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

ARTICLE III - POWERS

In furtherance of its purpose, the corporation shall have the following powers:

1. To hire, lease, buy, inherit, or otherwise acquire and hold land, buildings, equipment, or other real or personal property for a Girl Scout office, camp, or similar purpose; to build, construct, operate, and manage the said property for the benefit of Girl Scouting; and to rent, lease, mortgage, or sell all or part of such real or personal property acquired by said corporation.

To do, perform, and supervise any and all things in furtherance of the general purpose hereinbefore expressed and not inconsistent with Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes as may be amended from time to time, and to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon corporations formed under the laws pursuant to, and under which, this corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect and may at any time hereafter be enacted or amended.

ARTICLE IV - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the corporation shall be located in the City of Jacksonville, County of Duval, State of Florida.

ARTICLE V - DIRECTORS

The number of directors of the corporation shall be at least 20.

None of the assets or earnings of the corporation shall be paid or accrued for the benefit of any of its members, directors, officers, or employees, or any other individual, whether before, upon, or after dissolution or liquidation, except as reasonable compensation for services rendered, property transferred, or as reimbursement for expenses incurred, in conducting its affairs.

ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation, after all liabilities and obligations of the corporation have been paid, satisfied, and discharged, or adequate provision made therefor, all remaining property and assets of the corporation shall be distributed, conveyed, assigned, or transferred to organizations which comply with the following conditions: Such organizations must be chartered or licensed by Girl Scouts of the U.S.A., and shall be organized and operated exclusively for educational or charitable purposes as contemplated by Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or such remaining assets shall be placed in trust with Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. for the benefit of Girl Scouting, pending the inclusion of the jurisdiction of the dissolved Girl Scout council in the jurisdiction of another Girl Scout council.

ARTICLE IX - TERM

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, provided that a charter from Girl Scouts of the United States of America is held by the corporation.

ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS

These articles may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members voting at a meeting of the council, provided that the proposed amendment shall have been included in the notice of the meeting.
