Received your letter No. 901A00063443 with our check \$ 175.00, for-renewal of the non-profit corporation, Glossa's Children's Aid Association Inc. as a Charity.

I would like to clarify why the non-profit corporation was administratively dissolved because in 1998 the prior President Mr. Demetrios Magoulas attempted to legally dissolve the corporation but failed. The case numbers are 96-1511 Div F and on appeal to the 1st Dist Court of Appeals No.97-04001. When I was involved and became Respondent to the case and won the issues on the merits. The Court order the viability of such corporation. When I became Respondent I had served notice to the Secretary of State to become a party respondent but no answer was filed. I am enclosing Orders to show that the previous president failed to file to renew status of the corporation. I believe that the Secretary of State Hon. Katherine Harris has the authority to waive the cost of renewal for the years we were in Court. The additional costs/fee of \$ 61.25 per year from 1998, till the present. We enclose a separate check of \$ 125.50 plus \$ 8.75 fee for a certificate of reinstatement that would place the corporation current for 2000-2002.

I made the corrections requested so that there will be no discrepancies. Please assist us to renew our status so that we can function legally again. I hope this explanation with the Court Orders will explain the reason annual fees were not filed with the new officers which you have now.

Thank you very much for your cooperation and assistance in this matter. Please convey my congratulations to Hon. Secretary Katherin Harris.

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ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION

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THIS CAUSE is before the court on Petition, filed September 20, 1996, by Demetrios Magoulas to dissolve Glossa's Children Aid Assoc., Inc. (GCAAI), a Florida not for profit corporation. The Court, having considered the Petition and being fully apprised in its premises, finds as follows:

Article VIII of GCAAI Bylaws does not mandate dissolution of the association due to lack of interest, but merely dictates what is to be done to available assets upon dissolution. Further, under Articles IV, V, and IX of GCAAI Bylaws, dissolution cannot be granted without the informed consent of the association's executive counsel, officers, and members. See also Florida Statutes §617.1402 (1995). As a matter of law, the Court cannot find that there is a "lack of interest" in this corporation or that the association's executive counsel, officers, and members have consented to the dissolution. Absent such consent this Court has no authority to grant this Petition, and the future of

this corporation shall be determined by its bylaws and the Florida Statutes.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Petition to dissolve Glossa's Children Aid Association is DENIED.
