

AMENDED AND RESTATED

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SAINT ANDREW'S SCHOOL OF BOCA RATON, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Statutes Sections 617.1002, 617.1006, and 617.1007, Saint Andrew's School of Boca Raton, Inc., 70 Florida not for profit corporation, hereby amends and restates its Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State of Florida on or about July 17, 1961 as set forth below. On May 9, 2008, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, the members of the Corporation entitled to approve these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation voted unanimously to approve these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval. Further, the Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation was approved by The Right Reverend Leopold Frade, Episcopal Bishop of the Diocese of Southeast Florida, as required by Article IX of the Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be SAINT ANDREW'S SCHOOL OF BOCA RATON, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows:

To found, establish, conduct, maintain, operate and perpetuate an independent school in Palm Beach County, Florida within the Episcopal tradition of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America; and

To generally do each and every lawful and proper act which may be necessary or expedient for the running, maintaining, operating and conducting of such a school.

The Corporation shall have such corporate powers as are granted in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, and all amendments subsequent thereto, together with such other additional powers as shall be reasonably appropriate and necessary for the full use and proper management of said school.

ARTICLE III

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless dissolved according to law. Upon dissolution of this Corporation, all of its assets remaining after payment of all liabilities, costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to an educational organization or organizations qualified as tax exempt under the appropriate provisions of the laws of the United States of America (at the time of adoption of this Article - Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code), the selection of the organization(s) to be in the absolute discretion of a majority of the Trustees of this Corporation.

ARTICLE IV

<u>Section I</u>: The operation and conduct of all of the business and affairs of this Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Trustees, which shall consist of no fewer than eleven (11) Trustees, duly elected in such manner as is set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

Section 2: The Episcopal Bishop of the Diocese of Southeast Florida shall automatically be a member of the Board of Trustees and the Bishop or his designated representative shall be entitled to vote at all meetings of the Board.

Section 3: The Board of Trustees shall include sufficient representation of Episcopalians to assure and sustain the school's continuing Episcopal identity. All Board members, regardless of religious affiliation, shall share the responsibility to support and articulate the school's Episcopal mission.

ARTICLE V

These Articles may be amended or altered by a vote of a majority of the Board of Trustees, provided, however, that such amendment or alteration be approved by the Episcopal Bishop of the Diocese of Southeast Florida and, if required by the Canons of the Episcopal Diocese of Southeast Florida, by the Executive Board of the Diocese and the Standing Committee of the Diocese.

ARTICLE VI

The principal office of this Corporation shall be located at Boca Raton, Palm Beach County, Florida, and branch offices may be maintained at such other locations in the State of Florida and in the United States of America and in foreign countries as may be from time to time authorized by its Board of Trustees.

The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the Board of Trustees on May 9, 2008.
