We, the undersigned Member and Trustees of ST. JOHN VIANNEY COLLEGE

SEMINARY, INC., a Florida corporation not for profit, in accordance with unanimous

Resolution passed at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of said corporation held on

February 11 , 1999, do hereby adopt the following Amended and Restated Articles of

Incorporation, pursuant to Article IX of the original Articles of Incorporation and amendments thereto.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be ST. JOHN VIANNEY COLLEGE SEMINARY, INC., with its principal place of business at 2900 S. W. 87 Avenue, Miami, Miami-Dade County, Florida 33165.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

- (a) To establish, maintain and operate St. John Vianney College Seminary (the "Seminary");
- (b) To train and educate men whose stated objective is to study for the priesthood of the Roman Catholic Church, and to provide general ancillary training and educational services to lay ministers and other persons who may be enriched by such services;

- (c) To acquire and maintain facilities for the operation and conduct of educational and scientific schools, institutes, classes and programs; to establish and maintain libraries, laboratories, museums and art galleries; and, in general, to do any and all things that may be necessary, advisable or customary in connection with the establishment, conduct and operation of a college seminary or university, and all activities and undertakings related thereto, including, but not limited to, the conferral of degrees;
- (d) To acquire, maintain and operate any and all facilities necessary or desirable for the education and training of men whose stated objective is to study for the priesthood of the Roman Catholic Church;
 - (e) To edit and publish papers, magazines, pamphlets, periodicals and books;
- (f) To acquire, maintain and operate any and all facilities necessary or desirable to the conduct of educational and scientific research, and to sponsor or conduct educational and scientific research programs;
- (g) To solicit, raise and receive funds and endowments for the purpose of carrying out the purposes of the corporation;
- (h) To purchase, own, hold, improve, rent or lease property, both real and personal; to acquire, by gift, devise, bequest or otherwise, property of any kind or character whatsoever and wheresoever situated; to sell, convey, pledge, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of or encumber any such property; to contract and to sue and be sued in its corporate name; to have a corporate seal; and to have any and all statutory and common law powers, including the corporate powers set forth in Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time, of a corporation not for profit; and,

(i) In general, to do any and all things as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes for which this corporation is formed.

ARTICLE III

The sole Member of this corporation shall be The Most Reverend John Clement Favalora, as Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Miami, and his successors in office. This corporation shall be governed by a Board of Trustees. The Member shall be a Trustee, and shall be entitled to vote on any and all matters that may come before the Board of Trustees. The responsibilities of the Board of Trustees include establishing broad policies of formation within the Seminary; establishing spiritual as well as educational programs of the Seminary; securing financial support for the Seminary; with the recommendation of the Rector of the Seminary (the "Rector"), approving faculty members; approving the annual budget, rate of tuition for both diocesan seminarians and others (which tuition rate may not necessarily be identical); and, approving extraordinary expenditures of money and capital improvements.

The following persons, by reason of their office, shall always be ex officio members of the Board of Trustees of this corporation:

- a. The Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Miami and his successors in office as such Archbishop;
- b. The Auxiliary Bishops of the Archdiocese of Miami and their successors in office as such auxiliaries;
- c. The Diocesan Bishops of the Province of Miami and their successors in office, subject to, and upon, the acceptance of such ex officio membership by any such Diocesan Bishop; and,
- d. The Rector of St. John Vianney College Seminary and his successors in office as such Rector.

At least seven (7) but not more than twenty (20) additional Trustees shall be appointed by the Member.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this corporation is to exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

Except for the *ex officio* Trustees, all other Trustees shall be appointed by the Member for fixed terms on a staggered basis. Once the rotation is established, the Trustees, except for the *ex officio* Trustees, shall serve for three-year terms and many be reappointed by the Member without limitation. Vacancies shall be filled by the Member, with the proviso that any person appointed to the unexpired terms of his or her predecessor may be reappointed at the expiration of the term of his or her predecessor, in the sole discretion of the Member.

ARTICLE VII

The Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Miami, and his successors in office as such Archbishop, shall be ex officio Chairman of the Board of Trustees. The other officers of the corporation shall be the President, the Secretary and the Treasurer, together with any assistant officers determined by the Trustees. Except for the Chairman and the President, all other officers of the corporation shall be elected by a majority vote of the members of the Board of Trustees, present and voting, and shall hold office for a term of three (3) years or until their respective successors are elected, subject to the approval of the Chairman of the Board.

ARTICLE VIII

This corporation is a corporation not for profit. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall be distributed to, or inure to the benefit of, any member, Trustee or officer of this corporation, contributor or private individual. In the event of dissolution, winding up, or other liquidation of the assets of this corporation, its assets shall revert to the Archdiocese of Miami and shall be transferred or conveyed to The Most Reverend John Clement Favalora, as Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Miami, or his successors in office, the same being a corporation sole and not for profit.

ARTICLE IX

The Bylaws of the corporation shall not be made, amended, altered or rescinded without the written approval of the Member.

ARTICLE X

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of the corporation shall not be made, amended, altered or rescinded without the written approval of the Member.
