PLAINTIFFS' NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE



RE: Cease and Desist Letter on behalf of The National Journalists Association of Cuba in Exile, Inc. and Colegio Nacional de Periodistas de la Republica de Cuba-Exilio, Inc.

Dear Mr. Romani:

This letter will serve as notice that this law firm represents The National Journalists Association of Cuba in Exile, Inc. (NJAC), a Florida nonprofit corporation, Number: 704687 / FEI/EIN Number 59-1753963, and Colegio Nacional de Periodistas de la República de Cuba-Exilio, Inc. (CNP), a Florida nonprofit corporation, Number: N13000004753 / FEI/EIN Number 46-2838679.

On May 30th, 2016, the duly elected Board of Directors of both of these corporations, respectively, lawfully adopted Articles of Merger, duly filed with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, whereby both became a single corporation.

If you are represented by legal counsel, please direct this letter to your attorney immediately and have your attorney notify us of such representation.

We have been made aware that you have continued to illegally use the corporate name and service mark of CNP and, now, the NJAC, for your personal use and financial gain. Your use of both the NJAC & CNP's corporate trade names and service marks is an infringement of our clients' rights and a violation of our clients' established common law trademark rights, common law service mark rights, and trade name rights. This action in and of itself is egregious and actionable as misappropriating NJAC & CNP's intellectual rights illegally for personal gains. You should know that this firm is prepared to immediately commence an action against you, if necessary.

This letter constitutes our clients' demand that you cease and desist any and all use of their corporate name and service mark. Both the NJAC & CNP are now merged nonprofit Florida

corporations representing Cuban journalists throughout the United State as well as other countries. The surviving corporation owns the attached service mark, registered the same on May 2013, and has continually used the trade name and service mark throughout the United States.

If the trade name and service mark owner were to file a lawsuit against you, it would be entitled to seek: (1) preliminary and permanent injunctions; (2) actual monetary damages; (3) disgorging of any profits you have realized through your use of their corporate name and mark;

If you do not comply with this cease and desist demand immediately, this firm will forthwith commence the litigation described and set forth above as well as other actions designed to force you to cease and desist from your unwarranted actions. If the corporate name and service mark owner were to file a lawsuit against you, it would be entitled to seek: (1) preliminary and permanent injunctions; (2) actual monetary damages; (3) disgorging of any profits you have realized through your use of the Marks; (4) reimbursement of attorney's fees required to prosecute a lawsuit against you; and (5) monetary damages for damage to its goodwill in the community.

Of course, NJAC & CNP will pursue all available remedies, both legal and equitable, including seeking monetary damages and injunctive relief. Your liability and exposure under such judicial action should be considerable.

Before taking these steps, however, my client wishes to give you one opportunity to discontinue your illegal conduct by complying with this demand. Accordingly, if you wish to avoid expensive and time consuming litigation, you should first notify this office via e-mail that you will cease and desist your illegal use of our client's corporate name and registered service mark, as well as any tortious interference forthwith.

You are hereby placed on notice that NJAC & CNP is the legal owner of this trade name and service mark and this firm will be monitoring your use of this name and mark for this purpose. Additionally, you must execute the following agreement and send it to this firm within seven (7) days of the receipt of this letter. I recommend you consult with an attorney, if you have not already hired one, should you have any doubts as to how to proceed.
