The undersigned officers of 426 Association, Inc. do hereby certify that the following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation are a true and correct copy as amended, pursuant to Article IX thereof, by the membership at a duly called and noticed meeting of the members held September 29, 1998 and adjourned and reconvened on December 27, 1998. The amendments were adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF 426 ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned hereby associate themselves for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, 1961, and certify as follows:

ARTICLE III

POWERS

The powers of the Association shall include and be governed by the following provisions:

- 2. The Association shall have all of the powers reasonably necessary to implement the purposes of the Association, including but not limited to the following:

- (e) To make and amend reasonable regulations respecting the use of the property in the condominium.; provided, however, that all such regulations and amendments thereto shall be approved by not less than 75% of the votes of the entire membership of the Association before such shall become effective.

ARTICLE V

DIRECTORS

1. The affairs of the Association will be managed by a board of not less than three nor more than 5 directors as shall be determined by the Bylaws, and in the absence of such determination shall consist of three directors. All directors must be members of the Association.

ARTICLE IX

AMENDMENTS

Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation shall be proposed and adopted in the following manner:

2. A resolution approving a proposed amendment may be proposed by either the board of directors or by a majority of the

membership of the Association, and after being proposed and approved by one of such bodies it must be approved by the other. Such approvals must be by all of the directors and by not less than 75% a majority of the members of the Association. Directors and members not present at the meetings considering the amendment may express their approval in writing.
