
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

BY THESE ARTICLES SARASOTA MEDICAL FOUNDATION INC amends its articles of incorporation as specified below:

- 1. $\underline{\text{NAME}}$. The name of the corporation is SARASOTA MEDICAL FOUNDATION INC
 - 2. AMENDMENT. The text of each amendment adopted is:

Article II

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- (a) To establish and maintain a medical foundation for education and research and to provide medical and scientifically related programs for the education of physicians and related professional persons in the Sarasota area and to provide programs of scientific investigations in basic science or the clinical aspects of medicine.
- (b) To promote by medical education and research programs to improve and maintain physical and mental health for publications, lectures, research, investigations, electronic media and such other methods as may be appropriate; to provide equipment and personnel to assist in the promulgation of the medical education and research programs; to make grants to the medical library at Sarasota Memorial Hospital; to build, equip, maintain and endow clinical buildings and facilities and to acquire the personnel and equipment necessary for them or useful or incidental to medical education and research or for research and training projects and programs; and to make grants to persons for their assistance in promoting the medical research and education programs under this article; to make grants to persons for their assistance in promoting the medical research and education program adopted by this corporation and to students who are conducting research in science and medicine or who are pursuing an education in science or medicine.

- (c) To collect and accumulate funds and other property; to receive donations; to hold and administer real and personal property for the purposes of this corporation;
- (d) To carry on any other business that will advance the programs of this corporation and that are not prohibited by law.

Article VII

The affairs and business of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees of not less than three nor more than seven members to be elected by the trustees at their annual meeting when scheduled by the Board.

If any member of the Board exhibits a lack of interest in and attention to the affairs of the corporation, that trustee may be removed by a two-thirds majority vote of the board; provided, that before any removal becomes effective, the trustee in question shall first be given 15 days written notice of the pendency of the removal proceedings and the date the proceedings shall be acted upon at which time the trustee shall be given an opportunity to be heard.

If a vacancy occurs among the membership of the Board, the Board shall elect a successor to serve out the unexpired term of the vacancy.

- 3. DATE. Each amendment was adopted on February 10, 2009 by the board of trustus.
- 4. APPROVAL. Members are not entitled to vote on a proposed amendment.
