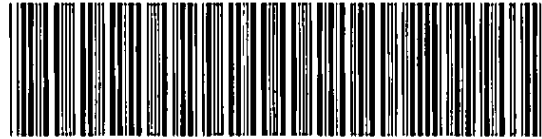

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of organizing a corporation, not for profit, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Florida, in such cases made and provided, for the purposes and in the manner hereinafter set forth:

(1) The name of the corporation shall be "Trinity College," and the principal office of the corporation shall be St. Petersburg, Pinellas County, State of Florida.

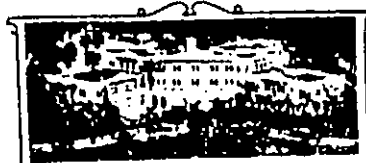

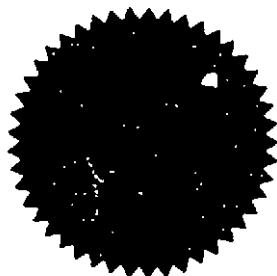

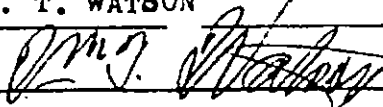

Now, the Board of Directors and members of "TRINITY COLLEGE" hereby propose and approve the following Amendment to the Articles of Reincorporation, stating that the first Articles of Incorporation were filed on the 30th day of April, 1947, and the Articles of Reincorporation were filed and approved by the Secretary of State on the 19th day of March, 1964, and we hereby adopt the following Amendment as a total replacement of those Articles:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The corporate name of this institution shall be TRINITY COLLEGE, and the principal office of the corporation shall be 453 Edgewater Drive, City of Dunedin, County of Pinellas, State of Florida.

ARTICLE II - OBJECT AND PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is formed shall be as stated as follows:

- A) To form a Christian corporation, NOT FOR PROFIT, to promote the cause of the Christian religion in accord with the New Testament; and to form this religious corporation, not for profit, pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida.
- B) To teach and train youth and adults for Christian service.
- C) To grant certificates, diplomas and degrees to those completing prescribed courses.
- D) To grant honorary degrees to those deserving same by accomplishments, as approved by the Executive Board of Directors.
- E) To promote and conduct Bible and missionary studies, and to promote and conduct Bible and missionary conventions and conferences.
- F) To teach, preach, and broadcast by public media and promote world-wide evangelism.
- G) To adopt, alter, amend, and repeal Articles of Incorporation, By-laws, and Rules, not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

H) To promote Bible Schools, Sunday Schools, and religious work among young people.

I) To buy, sell, donate, and receive religious literature, pictures, caps, hymns and songs, and in general to do any and all things convenient or necessary to carry out the above purposes for which an individual, religious body or school engaged in a similar enterprise might or could legally perform.

J) To buy, sell, own, donate, receive, lease and exchange real property and personal property and to receive and make subscriptions, offerings, donations, annuities, livings, allowances, supports and apportionments for these purposes.

K) To acquire, alienate, encumber, build and improve, repair and insure the real and personal property of the corporation.

L) To engage in any lawful activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida, which may enable this corporation to operate and to carry out the above purposes.

M) The purposes for which this corporation are formed are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (C)(3) and Section 509 (A)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code, and it is the intention of this corporation to continue to comply with these sections or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE III - STATEMENT OF FAITH

Each member of the Board of Directors, Administrative Officers and faculty will give evidence of the whole-hearted accord with the following Statement of Faith:

A) We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament as verbally inspired by God, and inerrant in the original writings, and that they are the supreme and final authority in faith and life.

B) We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

C) We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man.

D) We believe that man was created in the image of God and that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also that spiritual death, which is separation from God.

E) We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all that believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood.

F) We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into heaven, and His present life there for us, as High Priest and Advocate.

G) We believe in "that blessed hope", the personal, premillennial and imminent return of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

H) We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting felicity of the saved, and the everlasting conscious suffering of the lost.

ARTICLE IV - EXISTENCE

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

The members of the corporation and the Board of Directors shall be dedicated Christians who evidence deep spirituality and active love for the work of Christ. They must be in agreement with the objectives of the corporation/college and show active interest in its operation. They must freely subscribe to the Statement of Faith contained in Article III, believing without reservation in the infallibility and authority of the Scriptures.

The members shall be nominated by a Nominating Committee of the Board, consisting of at least three members, elected by the Board, with the Committee responsible to confer in advance with each nominee to give assurance of doctrinal and philosophical suitability for service, with the list of nominees given in writing to the Board at least 30 days in advance of their election. They shall heartily subscribe to the College's doctrinal statement and theological position. They shall be in complete accord with the objectives of the College and with the Bible College philosophy of education.

The members shall be elected by the Board of Directors, after due notice, at the annual meeting of the corporation held in the Fall of the year on the campus of TRINITY COLLEGE.

ARTICLE VI - GOVERNING BODY

The Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors, which shall have the management and final settlement of financial and business matters, educational program, and physical facilities. The Board of Directors shall be the final authority for all operations and decisions.

Officers of the Board of Directors shall be Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and the President of the College. These officers shall constitute the Executive Committee of the Board; this committee shall meet as often as necessary between meetings of the full Board of Directors and transact such necessary business as may arise, subject to approval of the Board of Directors (except those items coming within stated policies and directives of the Board).

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than 13 members plus the President of the College. In selection of Board members, consideration shall be given to bring balanced representation between Christian laymen and ministers, between denominational affiliations, between geographic locations, and between the various segments of the College's constituents.

The Board of Directors shall be duly elected at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII - ELECTION OF BOARD

A. Terms of Office

Members of the Board of Directors, with the exception of the College President, shall be elected to serve for terms of three years. In case of a vacancy, the Board shall elect a person to complete the term of the Board member who has vacated the office, even though that term be less than three years. Elections shall be executed in such a manner that one-third of the Board members shall be retired each year.

B. New members of the Board shall be elected by unanimous vote of the Board of Directors. Incumbent members may be re-elected by a three-fourths vote for a second term. After serving on the Board for two terms (normally six years), the Board member cannot continue to serve and is not eligible to be re-elected to the Board. However, Board members retired after two terms are eligible to be re-elected after a one year absence from the Board of Directors. The election of Board members shall be at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE X - BOARD OF DIRECTORS (CURRENT)

The number of persons constituting the Board of Directors shall consist of not less than 13 members plus the President of the College. The names and addresses of the persons who currently serve as Directors of this Corporation are included on the attached form, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS TO THESE ARTICLES
AND ADOPTION OF BY-LAWS

The amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed and passed at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors, provided that the proposed amendment shall be submitted by the Secretary to the membership 30 days prior to the meeting at which the amendment is to be considered. Notice may be given as provided in the By-Laws. A three-fourths vote of all members present or voting by proxy shall be necessary for adoption.

The By-Laws of this Corporation may be enacted, altered, or rescinded by the Board of Directors as they deem proper and necessary, for their government and the government of the Corporation and the management of its affairs. The By-laws may be enacted, altered or rescinded by a simple majority of the Board of Directors, after due notice has been given prior to the meeting at which the By-laws are to be considered, and a majority vote of all members present or voting by proxy shall be necessary for adoption.

ARTICLES XII - INDEBTEDNESS AND REAL ESTATE

This Corporation may subject itself to indebtedness or liability in an aggregate amount approved by the Board of Directors and ratified by three-fourths of all members present or voting by a proxy at a regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors.

The amount of real estate which the Corporation may hold shall be an amount as approved by the Board of Directors by three-fourths of the members present or voting by a proxy at a regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XIII - PROXY VOTING

At any regular or specially called meeting of the Board of Directors or the membership, proxy voting is permitted by written proxy, and the evidence of the written proxies may also be used to constitute a quorum for the conduct of all necessary business. However, the Secretary shall endeavor to include to all members and Directors, along with due notice of that meeting, a basic agenda as complete as possible, so that the individual members of the Board and of the Corporation may give an informed written proxy for that meeting.

Regular meetings shall be held at least twice a year during the Fall and Spring semesters of TRINITY COLLEGE. The Chairman or a majority of members of the Board shall have the power to call special meetings.

ARTICLE XIV - ACTIVITIES AND EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or any other private persons on the Board of Directors, except that the Corporation shall

be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.

No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activity not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from the federal income tax under Section 501 (C)(3) and Section 509 (A)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 509 (A)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE XV - DISSOLUTION

The dissolution of this Corporation may only be determined by a majority vote of the membership of this Corporation, present and voting, at a regular or special meeting of the membership and the Board of Directors, providing that notice has been previously given to the entire membership at least 30 days in advance of that meeting in which the question of dissolution will be raised.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying and making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of this Corporation in such manner or to such organization, organized and operated for similar purposes, specifically for the advancement of the Christian religion or Christian education as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (C)(3) or 509 (A)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law, as the Board of Directors shall then determine. Any of the assets not so disposed of shall be distributed by the Court of proper jurisdiction of Pinellas County,

Florida, in which the principal office of this Corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as the Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for the foregoing purposes.

ARTICLE XVI - INDEMNITY OF OFFICERS AND BOARD MEMBERS

Any person made a party to any action, suit, or proceeding, by reason of the fact that their personal representative is or was an officer, Director, or employee of this Corporation, or a member of this Corporation, or of any corporation which they served as such at the request of this Corporation, shall be indemnified by this Corporation against the reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, actually and necessarily incurred by them in connection with the defense of such action, or in connection with any appeal therein, except in relation to matters to which it shall be adjudged in such action or suit that the officer, Director, or employee, or member of this Corporation is liable for gross negligence or misconduct in the performance of their duties.

The foregoing right of indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which any officer, or Director, or employee, or member of this Corporation may be entitled, apart from the provision of this Article.

As soon as convenient after the approval of these amended Articles, the Board of Directors shall convene and adopt appropriate By-laws consistent with these Articles.

These Articles of Reincorporation have been duly authorized and adopted by a special meeting of the members duly called according to the terms of the existing Articles.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we the members and Board of Directors of TRINITY COLLEGE do approve these amended Articles of Reincorporation and do request the Department of State of the State of Florida to approve and file these Articles for a Corporation Not for Profit in the State of Florida. Done and performed at a special meeting of the membership and Board of Directors on this 23rd day of AUGUST, 1985.

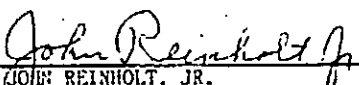

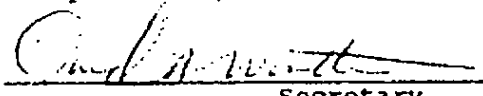

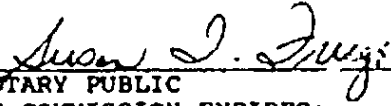
