RESTATEMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC.

We, the undersigned, as the Board of Directors of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC., a not for profit corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida on May 10, 1965, do hereby amend and restate the Articles of Incorporation of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC., as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME AND LOCATION

The name of this corporation is KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST,

INC. This corporation's mailing address is 921 West Vine

Street, in the City of Kissimmee, County of Osceola and State of Florida.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE AND NATURE

The purposes of this corporation are to promote and support religious, Divine and Christian worship as taught by the New Testament, and the transaction of such secular business for the maintenance of said association for such religious purpose, it being understood that the basic fundamental principles of this association and the religious worship to be conducted in connection therewith, shall, in all respects, conform to the

teachings and examples contained in that part of the Holy

Scriptures known as the New Testament, without any additions to,

or subtractions from, among which fundamental principles are:

- (a) That Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of God, the Father; that His Kingdom for the spiritual salvation of men and women was established on the first Pentecost after His crucifixion, and that Christ is now ruling upon His throne, and that His laws, as promulgated by Him and through his Apostles and inspired writers, under the guidance and direction of the Holy Spirit, are absolute and exclusive for the governing of His body, the church, in all spiritual or doctrinal matters. This paragraph is intended to exclude as active and participating members of this congregation or religious body, among others, any and all persons advocating and/or teaching the "premillennial theory" and/or teaching or advocating that the Bible teaches a return and earthly reign of Christ as a temporal King upon Earth for one thousand years, or for any period of time, prior to the day of final judgment.
- (b) Faith, Repentance, Confession, and Baptism are essentials for the admission of an alien sinner to the Church, or Kingdom of Christ.
- (c) That the local congregation of the Church of Christ is all and the only organization authorized to carry on Christian work or worship, and that such organization excludes

each and every other organization, for the purpose of conducting or carrying on religious work or worship, whether the same be missionary or otherwise.

- (d) That the teaching of the Bible is and will be sponsored by said organization under the direction of its officers on Sunday and on any other days of the week that the opportunity and expediency of the time and occasion may authorize, by teaching the Bible or any part thereof, with or without lesson helps, lesson aids and commentaries, and by teaching the congregation as a whole, in one body, or by dividing the congregation present into suitable and proper classes, the expediency thereof to be determined by the elders or proper officials of said congregation.
- (e) That no mechanical musical instrument of any kind whatsoever shall ever be used in connection with the song service or worship or work to be carried on or conducted by said congregation or religious body.
- (f) That no creed, other than the New Testament, shall ever be used, prescribed, or enforced in whole or in part on said religious body or any of its members in connection with the work and worship to be carried on by said religious body.
- (g) The support of such organizations as care for orphans, dependent children, aged and such, shall not be opposed or forbidden.

(h) The support of and/or cooperation with sister churches in evangelistic, missionary, or benevolent work, shall not be opposed or forbidden.

ARTICLE III

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

The members of this corporation are the members of the congregation of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, who have heard the Gospel of Christ (Romans 10:17); who believe the Gospel (John 8:24); have repented of their sins (Acts 3:19); confessed Christ as the Son of God (Romans 10:9-10) and have been baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit for the remission of sins, Matthew 28:19; who hold fast the truths, once and for all delivered unto the Saints.

No person may be a member of this corporation who believes, advocates or endorses the use of mechanical instruments of music, of any size or description, in worship services; no person may be a member of this corporation who believes, advocates or allows a millennialist to teach or preach or preside in worship services or Bible classes or to represent or hold authority with relation to a congregation of the Lord's church; no person may be a member of this corporation who opposes the spreading of the gospel by the use of the printed or written as well as the orally spoken word; no person may be a member of this corporation who

opposes the classification of persons of various and corresponding ages in Bible study classes; no person may be a member of this corporation who believes, advocates or demands that the Lord's Supper be observed only in an upper room, or only with one single cup shared by the entire congregation present; no person may be a member of this corporation who opposes cooperation or assistance, financially or otherwise, between congregations of the Lord's church; no person may be a member of this corporation who opposes such work as carring for orphans, widows, aged and sick; no person may be a member of this corporation who does not believe and espouse that Jesus Christ is the only son of God, the Father, that He now rules upon His throne in His Kingdom the church; and no person may be a member of this corporation who does not believe, advocate and support that the local congregation of the church of Christ is authorized to carry on Christian work or worship whether the same be missionary or otherwise.

The voting members of this corporation shall be the adult male members of the congregation of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, in accordance with the terms of the New Testament.

ARTICLE IV

DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence until dissolved under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS

This corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors

consisting of three of more members. The elders of this local

congregation of the church shall compose the Board of Directors.

If two or more elders are not available to serve, three or more

adult male members of the congregation shall serve on the Board

of Directors. Directors who are not elders shall serve only

during such periods of time as there are not elders; except that,

if fewer than three elders are serving, one adult male member of

the congregation shall serve as the third Director. The manner

of appointing elders and other directors shall be set forth in

the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII

OFFICERS

The directors shall appoint a President, Vice President,

Secretary and Treasurer. One person may hold two offices, except

that the President may not also be the Secretary.

ARTICLE VIII

MUSIC

For the purposes of this article, the term "facilities" shall include the building located at 921 West Vine Street, commonly referred to as the main building, which is used for worship services, public Bible classes, vacation Bible school classes, training classes, college singing groups, youth activities, fellowship activities, showers, weddings and funerals. The term "facilities" shall also include any other buildings or structures located on real property held by this corporation, excluding any building used primarily for residential purposes.

No individual or group shall be permitted to bring into the facilities of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC. any mechanical musical instrument, including, but not limited to, pianos, organs, guitars, harps, trumpets, horns, flutes, tambourines, cymbals and drums. Neither shall mechanical or electronic reproduction of instrumental music be permitted within these

facilities. All music for any activities held in the facilities, including but not limited to worship services, Bible classes, vacation Bible school classes, training classes, college singing groups, youth activities, fellowship activities, showers and funerals, must be a cappella (only vocal) singing. Mechanical or electronic reproduction, including amplification, of a cappella music (vocal with no instrumental accompaniment) is permitted.

Exception #1: For weddings, audio tapes that include instrumental music may be used, but no physical musical instruments may be brought into the building.

Exception #2: Videos and movie cassettes may be used for entertainment, training classes, and Bible classes. No mechanical music, recorded or otherwise, shall be used in conjunction with any worship service at any time.

Any individual or group desiring to use the facilities of the congregation must sign a statement agreeing to abide by these conditions before permission may be given for use of any facility.

ARTICLE IX

AMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS

A majority of the directors of this corporation shall have the power to make, alter, amend or rescind the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

Any one director of this corporation shall have the power to propose an adoption, alteration, rescission or amendment of or to the Articles of this corporation. Upon such proposal, a three-quarters majority of the directors of this corporation may make such an adoption, alteration, rescission or amendment of the Articles of this corporation effective.

ARTICLE XI

MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS

The maximum amount of indebtedness which this corporation may incur at any one time shall be \$1,000,000.00.

ARTICLE XII

DISSOLUTION

If this corporation should be dissolved, no part of this corporation's property or proceeds derived therefrom shall be distributed to any person or firm operating for profit or for any purpose inconsistent with the purposes and nature of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC. as set forth in Article II of these Articles of Incorporation. The Elders, or if no more than one exists, the Board of Directors shall jointly hold a limited power of appointment over the corporation, its property, and proceeds

derived therefrom. This limited power of appointment empowers its holders:

- 1. To merge this corporation with a corporation not for profit which upholds a purpose consistent with the primary purpose of the KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC. as set forth in Article II of the Articles of Incorporation; and
- 2. To distribute the property of this corporation as well as proceeds derived therefrom to a corporation not for profit which upholds a purpose consistent with the primary purpose of the KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC. as set forth in Article II of the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE XIII

USE OF INCOME

All revenue, profit, income and money received by this corporation is to be used and_employed in religious, educational, charitable, benevolent and missionary work and not for the monetary gain of individual members of this corporation.

ARTICLE XIV

CHURCH DISCIPLINE

To assure that the Church remains pure and holy, to encourage transgressors to repent and to return to fellowship with other members, Church discipline, a divine command of God,

is to be in accordance with Matthew 18:15-17 and other New Testament scriptures.

Elders under God claim authority for administering discipline in discharging their functions under the terms:

Overseers (Acts 20:28), Pastors (Ephesians 4:11), the ones having the rule over you (Hebrews 13:17).

Subjects of Church discipline are any member of the congregation that transgresses the law of Christ and will not repent (II John 9 & 10, Romans 16:17, Hebrews 10:25, I Corinthians 5:11, II Thessalonians 3:6, Matthew 18:15-17, Titus 3:10 and other New Testament scriptures).

Church discipline as specified in Matthew 18:15-17 is applied with love, without prejudice or partiality:

- a. Go and tell him his fault between you and him alone (Matthew 18:15);
- b. If he will not hear thee, take with you one or two (Matthew 18:16);
- c. If he will not hear them, tell it to the Church (Matthew
 18:17);
- d. If he will not hear the Church, let him be unto thee as a heathen man and a publican (Matthew 18:17). If the transgressor will not repent, he is to be withdrawn from by the congregation (II Thessalonians 3:6).

Article X of the Articles of Incorporation of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC., adopted under the laws of the State of Florida on May 10, 1965, require that the Board of Directors of the corporation approve every amendment to the Articles of Incorporation and present it before the active male members at a meeting. If a majority of said male members present at the meeting approve the amendment, the Directors and all active male members must sign a written statement recognizing the amendment to the Articles of Incorporation.

The Board of Directors of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC. unanimously adopts the attached Restatement of Articles of Incorporation of KISSIMMEE CHURCH OF CHRIST, INC., approving all amendments thereto.
