Pursuant to the provisions of § 617.1006, Fla.Stat., the undersigned Florida corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

1. Amendments adopted (strike-through text indicates deletions; underlined text indicates additions): Article II is amended as follows:

Article II

The general nature of the object and purposes of this corporation shall be to provide facilities and services for recreational, social and leisure time activities of the members, and others authorized to enjoy the facilities of the corporation, to own and operate recreational areas, parks and playgrounds, to own and operate a water distribution system and a sewage disposal system, to own utility areas, to charge owners for expenses incurred in removal of unapproved personal property from common areas, to impose and collect assessments as set forth in the Association's bylaws, including the ability to impose fines and collect attorney's fees for enforcement and collection proceedings, and to own, maintain and operate real, personal and mixed property necessary or desirable for such purposes, and to engage in any other activities authorized by law.
