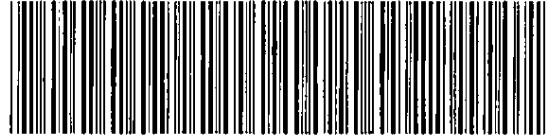

Article 6 Registered Office And Agent

The name and street address of the Registered Agent of the corporation is as follows:

Article 7 Members

This corporation shall have members. The eligibility, rights and obligations of the members will be determined by the organization's bylaws.

Article 8 Term And Dissolution

The date of commencement of corporate existence shall be when these articles have been filed with the Department of State and approved by it and the respective filing fee has been paid; the term for which the corporation is to exist shall be perpetual.

In the event of dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. In the case of the dissolution of Altamonte Christian School whereby the school should cease to continue in operation, the school will release and provide records by law, to the Seminole County Superintendent to be maintained at an alternate location other than Altamonte Christian School.

Article 9 Non Profit Organization

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article 3. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or: (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C) of the Internal

Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue laws.

Article 10 Bylaws

The bylaws of the corporation shall be adopted by the corporate membership and may be amended, altered, or rescinded by the board of directors in the manner provided by such bylaws.

Article 11 Amendments To Articles Of Incorporation

These articles of incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by statute or in the following manner:

Every amendment shall be approved by the corporate membership.
