Dear Katrina:

Per our telephone conversation, I have reviewed the records of the Cloverleaf 4-H Park of Christmas, Inc., and while I was unable to find documentation as to their 501(3)(c) I did find the following facts which I conclude establishes this corporation was and is in fact a 501(3)(c) Corporation as defined by the Internal Revenue Service:

1. The Cloverleaf 4-H Park of Christmas, Inc., was organized to provide educational programs for members of the 4-H boys and girls of Orange County, FL in the area of grazing, timber, recreation and other 4-H agricultural products. The programs continue to this day in cooperation with the Orange County Extension Service.
2. The property that Cloverleaf owns was donated to the organization and is currently tax exempt on the Orange County Tax Rolls.
3. The programs of the 4-H club receive donations from the public as well as Orange County.

As to the forms to keep the corporation from being dissolved administratively by the Department of Corporations back in 1973, I have reviewed the Cloverleaf records and can find no record of their having received said forms, thus the dissolution by administrative action.

I hope this letter provides enough information to allow your office to reinstate this corporation as a 501(3)(c) Non-Profit Corporation as requested in the Corporation
