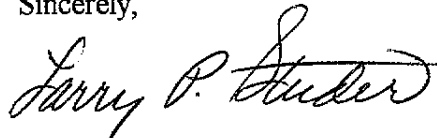

RESTATEMENT OF ARTICLES
WITH AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES
OF FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH, INC. OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation, pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by its Board of Directors and approved by the members of the corporation, adopts the following restated and amended articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be "Faith Baptist Church, Inc. of Orlando, Florida"

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES AND SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to be used by God to bring people into a saving, growing relationship with God in worship; to nurture God's people through authentic fellowship; and to equip them to reach out to the world for Jesus Christ through relationships with unbelievers.

In order to accomplish these purposes, the corporation has the following specific objectives:

- To provide a spiritual fellowship among New Testament believers of Orlando and its vicinity;

- To maintain a place of worship and prayer, with faithful recognition of the New Testament doctrines and ordinances;

- To provide a center of training for the whole family in Bible doctrine and practice;

- To give training and incentive to a program of continuous witnessing under the direction of the Holy Spirit;

- To teach and give example of faithful stewardship at home and across the seas;

- To provide missionary education and outreach;

- To give faithful acknowledgment to all that is contained in our New Testament Covenant as outlined in the Bylaws;

- To encourage the establishment and growth of additional local churches or missions of like faith and practice.

ARTICLE IV - POWERS

In addition to all those rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon not-for-profit corporations, the corporation shall have the power to purchase take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise, or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and deal in and with real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated; to sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, or any interest therein; to make donations for religious, charitable, or similar purposes; and to own, sell, convey, mortgage, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise hold and manage property, real or personal, as trustee.

ARTICLE V - QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications of the members, such persons professing their belief in the statement of religious doctrine, principles or their equivalent, and the manner of their admission are as follows:

1. We believe that the Bible is God's Word, that it was written by men divinely and uniquely inspired, that it is absolutely trustworthy and has supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.
2. We believe in God the Father, Creator of heaven and earth, perfect in holiness, infinite in wisdom, measureless in power. We rejoice that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ.
3. We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, sinless in His life, making atonement for the sin of the world by His death on the cross. We believe in His bodily resurrection, His ascension into heaven, His high priestly intercession for His people and His personal, visible return to the world according to His promise.
4. We believe in the Holy Spirit, who came forth from God to convince the world of sin, of righteousness and of judgment and to regenerate, sanctify and comfort those who believe in Jesus Christ.
5. We believe that all men by nature and by choice are sinners, and that "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." We believe, therefore, that those who accept Christ as their Lord and Savior have everlasting life and "shall not come into condemnation; but are passed from death unto life," and will rejoice forever in God's presence, and those who refuse to accept Christ as Lord and Savior will be forever separated from

God.

6. We believe in the Church - a living, spiritual body of which Christ is the Head and of which all regenerated people are members. We believe that a visible church is a company of believers in Jesus Christ, buried with Him in baptism and associated for worship, work, and fellowship. We believe that to these visible churches were committed, for observance "till He come," the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper; and that God has laid upon these churches the task of persuading a lost world to accept Jesus Christ as Savior and to enthrone Him as Lord and Master. We believe that human betterment and social improvement are essential products of the Gospel.
7. We believe in the principle of heart separation from sin and unto God, producing in the believer a life free from worldly habits and consecrated to the will of God, as the Scriptural pattern for greatest joy, blessing and usefulness.
8. We believe that each church is independent and autonomous, and must be free from interference by any ecclesiastical or political authority; that, therefore, Church and State must be kept separate as having different functions, each fulfilling its duties free from the dictation or patronage of the other.

In addition to giving assent to the above Declaration of Faith, applicants for membership must give evidence of conversion and regeneration, submit to the ordinance of baptism by immersion, agree to the Covenant as outlined in the Bylaws, and be accepted by a majority vote of the members of the corporation then in good standing who shall be in attendance at the time such person is proposed for membership.

Membership in this corporation may also be obtained by letter from another church of like faith and practice, by Christian experience and previous immersion, or by restoration by a majority vote of the members of the corporation in good standing and in attendance at the time the admission of such person is proposed.

Members may be expelled in such manner as may be outlined in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its property controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors (the Board of Directors may also be referred to as the "Board of Elders." These two terms shall be considered to be the same.) The number of directors shall be no less than five (5) nor more than twenty (20). Within these limits, the number of directors shall be set by the Bylaws of the corporation.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors may be taken

without a meeting, if all the members of the Board shall consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote by the Board of Directors.

The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected according to the method stated in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII - NOT FOR PROFIT

The corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes, is not formed for pecuniary profit or financial gain, and no part of the assets, income, or net earnings of the corporation is distributable or inures to the benefit of its members, directors, officers, or any private individual, but the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

The corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, attempt to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise. The corporation shall not directly or indirectly participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

On liquidation or dissolution, all assets of the corporation remaining after paying or providing for all debts and obligations shall be distributed and paid over to such fund, foundation, or corporation organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, or educational purposes as the Board of Directors of the corporation shall determine, with ratification by affirmative vote of no less than three-quarters (3/4) of the members in good standing, and as shall at that time qualify as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future Internal Revenue Code or law, as may be amended.

ARTICLE VIII - BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend, and repeal the Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors, but all alterations, amendments, and repeals of the Bylaws must be approved by a majority of the members of the corporation who are authorized to vote.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

Amendments to these articles may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors and presented to the members at a duly called meeting of the members. Amendments must be approved by a majority of the voting members present at the meeting, provided that a quorum is present at the beginning of the meeting.

ARTICLE X - STABILITY OF DECLARATION OF FAITH

The Declaration of Faith, as set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, shall never be altered, amended, or changed in any manner whatsoever during the existence of this corporation.

ARTICLE XI - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The street address and mailing address of the principal office of the corporation is 500 North Bumby Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32803.

ARTICLE XII - REGISTERED OFFICE

The street address of the registered office of the corporation is 500 North Bumby Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32803.

2. The restated and amended articles of incorporation restate and amend the articles of incorporation of the corporation.

3. The restated and amended articles of incorporation were adopted by the Board of Directors of the corporation on the 25th day of July, 2000.

4. The restated and amended articles of incorporation were approved by a majority of the members of the corporation on the 25th day of July, 2000, at a duly called meeting of the members of the corporation. The number of votes cast for the restated and amended articles was sufficient for approval.
