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

MINUTES OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES ST. PETER'S AFRICAN ORTHODOX CATHEDRAL, INC. April 29, 2007

On April 29, 2007, a Special meeting of the Board of Trustees of St. Peter's African Orthodox Cathedral, Inc. was held, The Board of Directors met at the Church facilities at 4841 NW 2nd Avenue, Miami, Fl 33127 at 10:00 AM for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation of the Church.

Those present at the meeting were Rev. George W. Sands, Ms. Karen Guillard-Jordan, Fredericka E. Stewart, and Eugene Rigby.

Rev. George W. Sands acted as Chairman of the meeting and Ms. Fredricka E. Stewart acted as Secretary of the meeting.

After discussion of the status of the Church's Application for Exemption filing with the Internal Revenue Service and upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously approved, it was resolved that the Articles of Incorporation be amended to include the following two statements:

St. Peter's African Orthodox Cathedral, Inc. is organized exclusively for religious and charitable purposes, specifically for the purpose of advancing the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the communities which are served by the Church. which includes supporting the initiation, promotion and maintenance of the ministry operations, acquiring, developing and maintaining property to be utilized for the normal and ordinary use of the church and its personnel. It is specifically intended that the activities of this Church be limited to and shall include only religious and charitable purposes within the meaning of those terms as used in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, but only such purposes as also constitute public religious and charitable purposes under the laws of the State of Florida; and, it is further intended that this Church be and remain qualified as religious institution under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, any and all assets shall be distributed to Holy Cross ProCathedral which is the Chancellery of the African Orthodox Church, Inc. and is located in New York City, New York.
