# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# ANCHOR-LINE YACHT CLUB, INC. (a Florida nonprofit corporation)

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, and Article XI of the Articles Of Incorporation, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following Articles Of Amendment to its Articles Of Incorporation.

## FIRST:

Article X of the Articles Of Incorporation is hereby revoked in its entirety and the following is substituted therefor:

# "ARTICLE X - BYLAWS.

Any member may propose a Bylaws amemdment. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing to the Club Secretary in turn, shall notify the membership thirty (30) days in advance of a regular meeting of the Board of Directors. A majority vote of the Directors present at two successive meetings shall be necessary for adoption of the amendment."

Paragraphs 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4. and 4.5 of ARTICLE IV of the Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, adopted June 3, 1998 and all provisions contained in the Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, adopted on December 2, 1998 are hereby revoked in their entirety and the following is substituted therefor:

"ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP.

4.1 SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP.

There shall be one class of membership in the Corporation, which shall be designated as a Social Membership.
4.2 RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES.

A member shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of the Corporation."
