ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a corporation for social and regulatory purposes, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I. Name.

The name of this corporation is: "Y.C.C.S. PROPERTY ARTICLE II. Purposes.

this corporation shall be:

- 1. To own, operate, maintain, supervise and establish facilities to be used for the benefit of owners of real property in The Yacht & Country Club of Stuart, who shall be members of this corporation.
- 2. To promote the common interests of the members who own property in The Yacht & Country Club of Stuart Subdivision.
- 3. In order to promote the purposes of this corporation, it may acquire property by grant, gift, purchase, devise or bequest, and hold and dispose of such property, whether real or personal, as the corporation shall require for the benefit of the members and not for pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE III. Qualification of Members

1. Voting Members.

Those eligible for voting membership in the Corporation shall be any person, partnership, corporation or other artifical person owning real property in the subdivision known as The Yacht and Country Club of Stuart,

and located in Martin County, Florida. Each voting member shall be entitled to one vote. Corporations, partnerships, joint ownerships (including ownership by husband and wife) shall not be entitled to more than one vote.

The Board of Governors shall have the sole power and authority to interpret the qualifications and voting rights as herein set forth and the intent thereof.

2. Non-voting Associate Members.

The Board of Governors may, from time to time, establish qualifications for Associate Members in the corporation who shall not be entitled to vote or otherwise participate in the operation and management of the corporation. If such members are authorized, they shall be disignated "Associate Members" and shall be subject to such rules and regulations as the Board of Governors may, from time to time, establish.

3. Admittance to Membership.

All applicants for membership in the corporation shall submit to the Secretary a written signed application, in the form provided, together with the dues or fees which may then be due. Applicants shall be admitted to membership only upon approval of a majority of the Board of Governors present at a regular or special meeting of the Board duly called and held at which a quorum is present and voting throughout.

4. Membership Fees.

Membership fees may be established by the Board of Governors as provided for in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV. Term of Existence.

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

Section 2. Upon proper notice the by-laws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of those members of the Board of Governors present at any regular meeting or any special meeting call for that purpose.

ARTICLE XI. Amendments.
