ARTICLE I Constituent Corporations

The name of each constituent corporation is Early Education and Care, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation, Jackson County School Readiness Coalition, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation, and Washington-Holmes School Readiness Coalition, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation.

ARTICLE II Merger

Under F.S. 617.1107, Jackson County School Readiness Coalition, Inc. and Washington-Holmes School Readiness Coalition, Inc., (herein collectively "the Coalitions") shall be merged into Early Education and Care, Inc. (the "merger").

ARTICLE III Surviving Corporation

Early Education and Care, Inc. shall be the surviving corporation of the merger.

ARTICLE IV Articles of Incorporation

The articles of incorporation of Early Education and Care, Inc. in effect immediately before the merger are not otherwise amended or changed by this merger.

ARTICLE VI Assets and Liabilities

On the effective date of the merger, the separate existence of the Coalitions shall cease and Early Education and Care, Inc., without further action, shall possess all of the rights and privileges of the Coalitions immediately preceding the merger. All assets of any nature of the Coalitions, without further action, shall be vested in Early Education and Care, Inc. immediately following the merger. Following the merger, Early Education and Care, Inc. shall be responsible for all liabilities and obligations of the Coalitions. Any claim existing or action or proceeding pending against the Coalitions may be continued as if the merger did not occur or Early Education and Care, Inc. may be substituted for the Coalitions in any such proceeding. Neither the rights of creditors of nor any liens on the property of the Coalitions or Early Education and Care, Inc shall be impaired by the merger.

ARTICLE VII Effective Date

The merger shall be effective on July 1, 2005.

ARTICLE VIII Abandonment

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this plan, this plan of merger may be terminated and abandoned by the board of directors of Early Education and Care, Inc. and the Coalitions at any time before the filing of articles of merger.
