Club of Jacksonville, Inc.


It has recently been brought to our attention that our corporate status was dissolved in 1974, a fact of which we were not aware. Apparently when our Club was incorporated in 1972, as indicated by the enclosed, no annual corporate report was filed on its behalf with the Department of State by our founding fathers who are no longer among our midst.

This is a service club, formed to aid in the support of local and state law enforcement agencies, as well as fire and rescue, as indicated by our Articles of Incorporation.

Since we were totally unaware of our corporate status until just recently, we would ask forgiveness of any and all penalties, acceptance of our past due fees, and reinstatement of our corporate status with the State of Florida, effective with the original date of incorporation, or effective as of the date of dissolution, whichever is correct. We have enclosed the Corporate Reinstatement form, together with our check in the amount of \$1,570.25 in payment of past due fees as quoted by your office.
