

RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE CONGREGATIONAL NAME

WHEREAS, the congregation of the Isle of Palms United Methodist Church indicated its preference, to change the Corporate name as part of the process of relocation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees accepted this vote as a mandate and took the decision to the church's Administrative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Council, through the Board of Trustees, called for the formation of a committee to guide the congregation through the process of changing the name, and

WHEREAS, the Committee, in consultation with the Administrative Council, conducted various means by which different names were nominated and voted upon;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that at such time as the congregation occupies the new facility at 1821 San Pablo Road, Jacksonville, Florida, 32224, the name shall be See of Faith United Methodist Church.

MINUTES

The District Superintendent, E. Keith Ewing, opened the meeting with prayer.


It was explained that the purpose of the conference was to vote on the name for our new congregation at 1821 San Pablo Road and that in order to cast a vote one must presently be a member of this congregation.

Because of a tie vote on our last ballot between the names Isle of Faith United Methodist Church and Shepherd of Faith United Methodist Church, our first order of business was to determine which of those two names would appear on our resolution. To accomplish this purpose ballots were passed out to all members. Votes were cast and ballots counted. The name ISLE OF FAITH received 30 votes and the name SHEPHERD OF FAITH received 23 votes.


Copies of the resolution to change the congregational name were passed out. The name "Isle of Faith" was to be placed on the resolution. Time was allowed for everyone to read the resolution. Keith Ewing asked if there were questions or discussion. There being no discussion, voting was done by voice vote. The "ayes" had it. The resolution was passed.

Keith Ewing commended Pastor Bordin for his faithful service to our congregation during this whole process of growing and moving. Our meeting was closed with a circle prayer.
