

ADOPTED AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TREASURE ISLAND TENNIS & YACHT CLUB CONDOMINIUM #2, INC.

The following is an adopted amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of Treasure Island Tennis & Yacht Club Condominium #2, Inc., recorded in Official Records Book 4135, Page 1558 et seq., in the Public Records of Pinellas County, Florida, and as subsequently amended.

NOTE: New wording is <u>underlined</u>, deleted wording is stricken through, and *** indicates omitted text.

Article IX, Section 2 of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMEN'TS

Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation shall be proposed and adopted in the following manner:

2. A resolution approving a proposed amendment Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by either the Board of Governors or by a petition signed by at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the Apartment Owners, provided that any amendment proposed by the Owners is subject to editing as to form and legality by legal counsel for the Association, the membership of the ASSOCIATION, and after being proposed and approved by one of such bodies, it must be approved by the other. The specific wording of any proposed amendments must be provided to all Owners at least fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting where the voting will take place, together with a notice of the membership meeting where the proposed amendments will be

behalf if they are unable to attend the meeting. Amendments must be approved by the Board of Governors by majority vote, and by no less than sixty-five percent (65%) of the total number of Anartment Owners who are eligible to vote. As to any amendments which are approved, a Certificate of Amendment signed by the president or vice president, with two witnesses and a notary, will be recorded in the Pinellas County Public Records with the approved appendments

discussed and voted upon, and a proxy form for the Owners to allow someone else to vote on their

Such approvals must-be by not less than seventy five (75%) percent of all of the Governors and by not less than seventy five (75%) percent of all of the members of the ASSOCIATION. Governors and members not present at the meeting considering the amendment may express their approval in writing within ten (10) days after such meeting and said amendment shall be effective when filed with the Department of State of Florida, and recorded in the Public Records of Pinellas County, Florida.
