ARTICLES & PLAN OF MERGER

Pursuant to Florida Statute 617.1101, the following Plan of Merger is proposed for the Compact of Martin County, Inc. and the Council on Aging of Martin County Foundation, Inc.

- The names of the corporations proposing to be merged are: Council on Aging of Martin County, Article 1. Inc. and Council on Aging of Martin County Foundation, Inc. The surviving corporation will be, COUNCIL ON AGING OF MARTIN COUNTY, INC. The terms and conditions of the proposed merger are as follows:
 - The Articles and By-laws of the Council on Aging of Martin County Foundation, Inc. will be abandoned.
 - b. The Articles and By-laws of the Council on Aging of Martin County, Inc. will be the surviving documents. There are no changes to the Articles of Incorporation.
 - c. All rights and responsibilities of the Foundation will be assumed and acknowledged by the Council on Aging of Martin County, Inc.
 - d. By operation of Florida Statute 617.1106, all title to property vested in the corporate parties shall be vested in the surviving corporation without reversion or impairment.
 - e. The surviving corporation, upon merger, shall be responsible and liable for all the liabilities and obligations of each corporation party to the merger.
- This Plan of Merger will be presented to the Membership of each of the two (2) corporations for their Article II. consideration.
- Upon approval by a majority of the Membership of each of the two (2) corporations, these Articles of Article III. Merger shall be executed and filed with the Department of State.

The effective date of the merger will be July 1, 2001.
