AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

UNITED METHODIST COOPERATIVE MINISTRIES/SUNCOAST OF THE ST. PETERSBURG DISTRICT, INC.

- 1. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation are executed pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1007 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as amended, such Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation to be effective September 24, 2004.
- 2. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly adopted by the member(s) of the Corporation on September 24, 2004. The number of votes cast for the approval.
- 3. The following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede the original Articles of Incorporation, as amended, in their entirety and shall be the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation.

PREAMBLE

We, the undersigned, all of whom are of legal age and representing the Gulf Central District of Florida Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida applicable to corporations not-for-profit, under the following proposed Charter.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be Untied Methodist Cooperative Ministries/Suncoast, Inc., and its office is located at 1625 Union Street, Clearwater, Florida 33755.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

The object, general nature and purpose of this corporation, subject to the laws, usage the Discipline of the United Methodist Church, shall be:

- To encourage and promote the material, social and spiritual concerns of the Christian faith in the Gulf Central District of the Florida Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church.
- To relate to all persons in their personal, social, economic, educational and spiritual needs.
- To cooperate with community agencies, governmental authorities and churches in improving the quality of life in areas served.
- 4. To support the programs and policies of the Gulf Central District and the Florida Annual Conference.
- To provide services which may accomplish the above listed purposes.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the Corporation shall be the membership of the Gulf Central District of the United Methodist Church.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless it shall be dissolved according to the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE V. POWERS

Under the auspices of the Leadership Council of the Gulf Central District of the United Methodist Church the Corporation shall have the power to fulfill its mission as outlined in Article II (PURPOSE), such as:

- 1. Seek out and develop lay and clergy leadership.
- Launch programs and services.
- Research and pursue funding for such programs and services that will enhance its mission.
- Coordinate resources.
- 5. Offer training and support to local churches.
- Seek positive ecumenical ties and cooperate in ecumenical endeavors.
- Assist, equip and support local congregations to be in mission and ministry in their communities.

- Provide concrete expressions of love and compassion to persons facing adversity in life through service, advocacy and education.
- Accept bequests, gifts and donations and disburse the same in accordance with the purpose of this Corporation.

ARTICLE VII. OFFICERS

The officers of the Corporation shall be president, vice-president, secretary and treasures, and such other officers as may be provided by the By-Laws. All officers shall be voting members of the Board of this Corporation and shall be elected at an Annual Meeting in the manner set forth in Article IX hereof, and in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIIL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall be made up of two-thirds United Methodist representatives from the District and one-third community representatives. This Board shall manage the business affairs of the Corporation. The Board of Directors including any duly elected officers shall not exceed twenty-one (21) members.

EX OFFICIO MEMBERS shall be:

District Superintendent or Appointee

District Lay Leader

District Board of Mission and Church Extension representative

District President of United Methodist Women or appointee

District President of United Methodist Men or appointee

District Leadership Council representative

The Directors shall serve until their successors are duly elected. The names and addresses of the Board of Directors are as follows: (see attached sheet)

ARTICLE IX. ANNUAL MEETING

There shall be an Annual Meeting held at such place and date as the District Superintendent may designate. The District Superintendent shall set the date and place of such meeting and send notices to the churches of the Gulf Central District of the community representatives on the Board. The Nominating Committee of the Board as prescribed in the By-Laws of the Corporation, shall

The Nominating Committee of the Board as prescribed in the By-Laws of the Corporation, shall submit to the Annual Meeting its recommendation of Officers and Directors for election and receive any nominations form the floor. Vacancies that may occur on the Board shall be filled as prescribed in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X. BY-LAWS

The Board shall adopt the Amended By-Laws of the Corporation. The Board at any regular scheduled meeting shall approve all subsequent amendments. Any Amendments to the By-Laws must be preliminarily approved by the Board at a regular meeting and must be approved by a majority vote at the next regularly scheduled meeting after notification to all Board members of the proposed change.

ARTICLE XI. QUORUM

A quorum for the transaction of the business of the Corporation shall be those officers and directors present and voting at any regular or called meeting of said Board as outlined in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE XII. RELATIONSHIPS

The Board, the officers, directors and members are accountable to the Gulf Central District and the District Superintendent. The employment of an Executive Director by the Board shall be done in consultation with and the approval of the District Superintendent and in compliance with the Book of Discipline. An annual written report and budget shall be made and presented to the District.

ARTICLE XIL AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the members at the Annual Meeting or Special Called meeting of the District and shall take effect at the close of the business of that meeting.

ARTICLE XIV. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any divided or share in the income from the undertaking of this Corporation. Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, all assets remaining after payment of the costs and expenses of such dissolution and the satisfaction of all accrued debts shall be distributed as provided in the <u>Book of Discipline</u> of the United Methodist Church. None of the assets shall be distributed to any individual, officer or director of this Corporation.
