Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted: The following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of First Presbyterian Church – Niceville, Inc. have been duly adopted:

Amend Title to read:

THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH - NICEVILLE, INC.

**b.** Amend Article I to Read:

NAME

First Presbyterian Church – Niceville, Inc.

**Amend** Article VI to Read: OFFICERS

> The Board of Directors shall consist of all Ruling and Teaching Elders actively serving on the Session, as elected by the communing members of the Church. The Moderator of the Session shall serve as President of the Board of Directors and of the Corporation. The Clerk of Session will serve as Secretary of the Board of Directors and of the Corporation.

Amend Article VIII to Read: MANAGEMENT OF THE CORPORATION ď.

> The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors, which shall be composed of not less than three members. Those persons listed in Article VII above will serve until the first election under the Articles of Incorporation.

**BYLAWS Amend** Article IX to Read: e.

> The Bylaws of this corporation may be made, altered, or rescinded by a two-thirds majority vote of the communing members present and voting at a called congregational meeting, provided that it shall have been read at two called congregational meetings including the action meeting. The quorum for congregational meetings will be as described in the Book of Church Order.

f. Amend Article X to Read: **AMENDMENTS** Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation shall be proposed by the Board of Directors and shall require a two-thirds majority vote of the communing members, present and voting at a called congregational meeting. The quorum for congregational meetings will be as described in the Book of Church Order.

## g. Amend Article XI to Read: POWERS

In order to accomplish the purpose of this corporation set forth in Article II of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall have the following powers: buying, renting, selling and mortgaging of the property, real, personal, mixed, tangible and intangible, of this Church; acquiring and conveying title to such property and holding and defending the same; the management of all funds and moneys of the Church; overseeing the worship, management and administration of the Church; and such other powers and authority as may be specified by the Book f Church Order or the laws of the State of Florida.

**SECOND:** The date of adoption of the amendments was:
