

### 2005 Annual Report

#### Introduction

The year 2005 was a productive year for the Central Florida Police Athletic League (CFPAL). During the year we served over 750 at-risk youth, providing over 85,000 client service hours to children who live in the Orlando (Mercy Drive, Willows, Pine Hills) and Winter Garden communities. Ruth Patrick joined the staff as Executive Director in January 2005 and has taken a leadership role in the fundraising, marketing, planning and day-to-day operations of the organization.

#### Programs

In 2005 youth, ages 5-18 participated in programs based at the City of Orlando, Northwest Community Center including: homework assistance, tutoring, cheerleading, basketball, football, soccer, and summer enrichment programs. A six-week summer program took place in Winter Garden in partnership with the City of Winter Garden Police Department. The Kids Café program operated for much of the year at the Northwest Community Center and served nutritionally balanced evening meals and/or snacks Monday through Thursdays, to children in the community.

#### Fund Raising and Finance (un-audited financial information)

In 2005 the organization received over \$ 230,000 in contributions, grants, community campaign contributions, and donor designated gifts. Successful fund raising activities, including The Pat Garrity Corporate Basketball Tournament, helped the organization diversify income sources. Approximately 18% of the organizations income is expensed on administration and fund raising activities.

#### Board of Directors

In 2005 the board of directors (14 members) met monthly and new officers were elected in December '05. The board of directors planned and organized several successful fund raising activities during the year including two corporate 3 on 3 basketball events, Citrus Bowl parking and the Pat Garrity Corporate Basketball Tournament. The board completed a revision of the strategic plan and organizational bylaws. Several new community/business representatives joined the board and attended new member orientation.

#### Collaborations

The organization maintained existing partnerships and developed several new community partnerships. Community partners include: The City of Orlando's Families, Parks and Recreation Department, Orange County Community Action Department, Teen Crime Prevention Academy, Esteem Inc., Adult Literacy League, Orange County History Center, City of Winter Garden Police Department, Healthy Community Initiatives, Orlando Police Department, Orange County Public Schools and Pine Hills Neighborhood Initiative.
