Our articles of incorporation were filed October 1, 1976, and we wish to make the following amendments:

Article II – Purposes

In addition to the existing purpose statement, please amend this section to also state:

The organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific purposes under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article XII - Non Profit Status

Please delete the existing statement and replace with this amendment:

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except with that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose cause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal

Revenue Code or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article XIV - Distribution of Assets Upon Dissolution

Please amend the existing statements with the addition of the following statement:

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one of more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government.

These amendments to the Anna Maria Island Privateers, Inc. Articles of Incorporation were accepted and approved by a two-thirds majority vote at a special meeting held on August 13, 2003.
