## AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE

## FRIENDS OF THE MILTON PUBLIC LIBRARY, INC. DOCUMENT NUMBER 737930 ORIGINALLY ORGANIZED AND FILED ON 26 JANUARY1977

- Article 7. The Articles of Incorporation and / or By-Laws of the Corporation shall be amended by a recommendation from a majority vote of the Board of Directors, timely notification of the membership of such proposed change, and subsequent two thirds majority affirmative vote by the members at a regular or special meeting duly called by the Board of Directors. By-Laws shall provide for the administration of the organization.
- Article 8. Said organization was and continues to be organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically this organization was formed as outlined in Article 2, and intends to utilize funds raised in support of the operation, public awareness, civic service, advancement of reading and information sharing, and/or improvement of the facilities, equipment, and educational materials provided by and for the Milton Public Library, Milton, Florida, or it's successor organization.
- Article 9. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) buy an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Article 10. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or the such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
