

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SECULIAR STREET BALLAST POINT BAPTIST CHURCH, TAMPA, FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned, being the duly elected Directors of BALLAST POINT BAPTIST CHURCH, TAMPA, FLORIDA, INC., whose Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Florida Secretary of State on September 26, 1977, which Articles were amended by Amendment to Articles of Incorporation on August 15, 2002, hereby manifest our intention that the said Articles of Incorporation be amended in accordance with the proposed Amendment set forth herein, pursuant to the provisions of Section 617, Florida Statutes; and do hereby request the approval thereof by the Secretary of State.

1. The following Article XIII be added to the existing Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE XIII

CERTIFICATE OF REINCORPORATION

Upon this Corporation's filing of the Articles of Incorporation on September 26, 1977, it was the intention of the Corporation to reincorporate the original Corporation, Trustees Ballast Point Baptist Church, which filed its Articles of Incorporation with the Hillsborough County Clerk of Circuit Court on April 28, 1949, as provided in Florida Statute Section 617.0901. Attached herewith is a certified copy of the Articles of Incorporation for Trustees Ballast Point Baptist Church dated April 28, 1949 and recorded in Official Records Book 28, Page 181 of the Public Records of Hillsborough County, Florida.

Pursuant to Article X of the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation, this Amendment was approved and adopted at a special meeting called for that purpose on March 26, 2003 by the Directors of the Corporation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of Ballast Point Baptist Church, Tampa, Florida, Inc., has been duly executed by the Directors of the Corporation on this 26 day of March, 2003.

JOINT UNANIMOUS WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE DIRECTOR AND TRUSTEES OF BALLAST POINT BAPTIST CHURCH, TAMPA, FLORIDA, INC. IN LIEU OF SPECIAL MEETING

Pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned, being all of the directors of BALLAST POINT BAPTIST CHURCH, TAMPA, FLORIDA, INC., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, (the "Corporation") hereby consent to and approve the following resolutions, which action shall have the same force and effect as if taken at a meeting of the board of directors:

RESOLVED, that the Corporation shall file Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation by adding an Article to clarify that the Articles of Incorporation should have been a reincorporation of the Trustees Ballast Point Baptist Church filed on April 28, 1949 in Hillsborough County, Florida.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the directors of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out this resolution and directed to deliver such corporate documents, certificates and other papers as may be required and to take such further actions as may be necessary or proper in order to consummate the matters authorized by this resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this written consent to such action may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same document, and that the document be filed with both the minutes of the proceedings of the board of directors of the Corporation.

TRUSTEES BALLAST POINT RAPTIST CHURCH, a Corporation New for Profit.

We, the undersigned members of BALLAST FOIRT BAPTIST CHURCH; hereby form ourselves and our successors into a corporation not for profit under the corporate name of TRUSTEES BALLAST POINT BAPTIST CHURCH, and hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation shall be TRUSTEES BALLAST POINT BAPTIST CHURCH, and it is located at Tampa, Hillsborough County, Florida.

ARTICLE II.

the general nature and object of this Corporation is to buy, purchase, own, acquire, by gift, devise, purchase or otherwise, real and personal property, and to build, erect, construct, provide for, maintain and equip suitable buildings, shurches, houses, etc. for the benefit, use and occupation of Ballast Point Baptist Church, its members and congregation, in maintaining and fostering public worship, and the preaching and tellibring of the Word of God and the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and for all other meetings and purposes of the said Ballast Point Baptist Church, its members and congregation. To build, construct, erect, maintain and equip schools, mission stations and mission churches, pastors, homes and such other houses or equipment as the church may desire for carrying on its work.

To receive, siminister, disburse and invest gifts, de-

To issue bends, notes, debentures and evidences or indebtedness, and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust or otherwise.

This Corporation is organized primarily for the purpose of holding the title to such property or properties as the said Ballast Point Baptist Church shall, from time to time, purchase or acquire, and it shall have power, from time to time, to make such contracts and to do such things as shall be authorized and directed by the members of said Ballast Point Baptist Church. This Corporation shall have no power to mortgage, sell, encumber, deed or otherwise dispose of any property without the written consent and direction of the said Ballast Point Baptist Church, evidenced by resolution of said Church duly passed.

ARTICLE III.

The membership of this Corporation shall consist of five members of the Ballast Point Baptist Church, at Tampa, Florida, in good and regular standing in said Church, to be elected by the said Church at its regular business meeting in September of each year, or as soon thereafter as convenient, to serve for a period of one year and until their successors are elected and qualified. If any member ceases to be a member of said Ballast Point Baptist Church in good and regular standing, he shall cease to be a member of this Corporation, and the vacancy may be filled by the members of said Church at any regular business meeting of said Church, or at a special meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE IV.

The term for which this Corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IX.

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which this Corporation may, at any time, subject itself shall be the

sum of \$500,000, provided any such sum or indebtedness shall not exceed in value the property of the Corporation.

This Corporation shall have power to bond or mortgage its property in a sum not exceeding \$500,000 for the purpose of carrying into effect the objects of its incorporation as set forth in this charter, or for any portion or part thereof.

ARTICLE X.

This Corporation may hold real estate in the value of \$500,000, subject always to the approval of the Circuit Judge.
