**ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT
TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
RURAL HEALTH CARE, INC.**

1. Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of Rural Health Care, Inc., is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE III

(a) The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is organized is to provide rural health care and preventive health education.

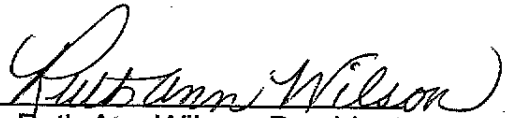
(b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are: To establish, maintain, and deliver health care services and preventive health education. The guiding principle of the corporation shall be that it is the right of every person regardless of race, sex, color, nationality, language, origin, or economic status to obtain health care services and preventive health education. To receive funds and to maintain real or personal property, or both, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth; to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary, or educational purposes either directly or by contribution to organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its related regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

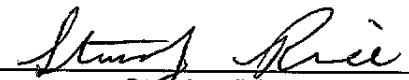
(c) This corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers conferred upon corporations under the laws of the State of Florida, provided however, that this corporation is now empowered to engage in any activity that in itself is not in furtherance of its purposes as set forth in subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this article.

2. The foregoing Amendments were adopted by the members of this

corporation on the 22nd day of April, 1998.
