

Developer reserves the right to designate successor Directors to serve on the First Board for so long as the First Board is to serve as hereinafter provided:

- 3. The holder of the Class B membership shall have the right to designate a majority of the Directors until the occurrence of the "Turnover Date," as defined below. The remaining Directors shall be elected annually by the the Class A members at the Annual Members Meeting.
- 4. Upon the occurrence of the "Turnover Date," each Class B membership Director shall be succeeded by a Director elected by the Class A members. The "Turnover Date" is the earliest to occur of the following:
