



ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SERENITY HOUSE OF VOLUSIA, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006 Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

Article I - Name

The name of this corporation is SERENITY HOUSE OF VOLUSIA, INC.

Article II - Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of providing a full range of services, including long term care, to indigent adults with serious substance abuse disorders. The corporation shall seek resources to fulfill this purpose by soliciting support from public and private sources and through charitable donations.

Article III - Term

The term for which the corporation is to exist is perpetual.

Article IV - Principal Place of Business and current Registered Agent

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 540 N. Ridgewood Avenue, P.O. Box 2196, Daytona Beach, Florida, 32115-2196. The current registered agent is Randall R. Croy. The registered agent may be changed by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Article V - Members

The members of the Board of Directors shall be the members of the corporation.

Article VI - Officers

The officers of the corporation shall be elected and their duties defined as provided in the By-Laws.

### Article VII - Board of Directors

The affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three persons. The Board of Directors shall be elected as provided in the By-Laws.

Article VIII - By-Laws

The By-Laws of the corporation shall be made, altered and rescinded by majority vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors.

Article IX - Amendments of Articles

These Articles may be amended only by two-thirds majority of a quorum of the Board of Directors.

Article X - Dissolution of the Corporation

Upon any dissolution of the corporation, the entire assets of the corporation shall be distributed solely to another organization which qualifies for exemption for taxation under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

These Articles of Amendment were adopted and executed this 25th day of July 2000 by the officers of Serenity House of Volusia Inc. by unanimous vote as provided by the corporation's unamended Articles of Incorporation.
