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

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO * ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TEMPLE BETH SHOLOM, INC.



Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida Nonprofit Corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: ARTICLE II is hereby amended to add the following:

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

SECOND: ARTICLE XII is hereby added:

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

THIRD: ARTICLE XIII is hereby added:

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

FOURTH:

The date of adoption of the Amendment was effective October 1, 2000.

FIFTH:

These Articles of Amendment were proposed by a majority of the Members of the Board of Directors at a special meeting held for such purpose and adopted by the general membership of the Corporation at a special meeting held for such purpose pursuant to Article X of the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation.
