

AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COMMUNITY HOSPICE OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of Community Hospice of Northeast Florida, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation (the "Corporation"), dated as of June 1, 2020, are being duly executed and filed by Susan Ponder-Stansel, its President and Chief Executive Officer, to amend and restate the Corporation's original Articles of Incorporation, which were filed on November 28, 1978, as amended by the Articles of Amendment on February 11, 1999. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly executed and are being filed in accordance with Section 617.1007 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation is Community Hospice of Northeast Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is 4266 Sunbeam Road Jacksonville, Florida 32257.

ARTICLE III Term of Existence

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV Sole Member

Alivia Care, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation (the "Member"), shall be the sole member of the Corporation. The Member shall be entitled to all rights and powers of a member under the laws of the State of Florida, these Articles of Incorporation, and the Corporation's Bylaws.

ARTICLE V Purposes and Powers

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law (the "Code"). Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation or the Corporation's Bylaws, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any director, trustee, officer, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation and payments and distributions may be made in furtherance of one or more of its purposes), and no director, trustee, officer, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distributions of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and

the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The Corporation is organized as a not for profit corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, for the following purposes:

- (a) To provide comprehensive palliative care to patients with advancing illness, to support the long-term well-being of such patients' families, to enhance the overall care of all persons with serious illness through education and advocacy, and to serve as a symbolic reminder that death is a part of life;
- (b) To make hospice services available to all terminally ill persons and such ill persons' families without regard to age, gender, religion, culture, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, diagnosis, cost of therapy, or ability to pay, and to respect the values, belief systems and choices of patients and families; and
- (c) Except as limited by these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation's Bylaws, and applicable law, to have and exercise all the corporate powers enumerated in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, restated, or renumbered from time to time, and all other powers consistent therewith and necessary and proper to the operation of the Corporation, including all powers implicit in the purposes outlined in these Articles of Incorporation and the Corporation's Bylaws.

ARTICLE VI Board of Directors

The number of directors on the Board of Directors of the Corporation (the "Board"), the procedure for election and appointment of such directors, and the powers of the Board shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII Registered Office and Registered Agent

The registered office of the Corporation is located at 4266 Sunbeam Road Jacksonville, Florida 32257, and the registered agent at such office is Susan Ponder-Stansel, whose acceptance of appointment as registered agent for the Corporation is set forth below.

ARTICLE VIII Distribution of Assets Upon Dissolution

Subject to any approvals described in the Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws of the Corporation, upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX Amendments

Subject to the ultimate approval of the Member, these Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority of the directors of the Corporation at the annual meeting or any regular or special meeting of the Board, provided written notice containing a full statement of the proposed amendment is sent to each of the directors, by mail, facsimile or email, at least five (5) days prior to the Board meeting at which the proposed amendment shall be presented.

ARTICLE X Adoption and Approval

The Member and the Board of Directors adopted and approved these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation on the 20th day of May 2020.

ARTICLE XI Effective Date

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation shall be effective on June 1, 2020.
