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

Amendment: Article X, Articles of Incorporation

## ARTICLE X

BY-LAWS: The By-Laws of this Corporation may be altered, amended or repealed, and new By-Laws may be adopted by a seventy—five percent (75%) vote of the members present and voting at any regular Annual Meeting of the Corporation, or at any Special Meeting called for that purpose, if at least fifteen (15) days written notice is given in advance of any such meeting of intention to alter, amend or repeal, or to adopt new By-Laws at such meeting in the manner provided in the By-Laws.

Amendment: Article XI, Articles of Incorporation

## **ARTICLE XI**

AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION: These Articles may be amended by a seventy-five percent (75%) vote of the members present and voting at any regular Annual Meeting of the Corporation, provided, however, that these Articles of Incorporation shall not-be amended unless written notice is first given of the proposed Amendment to each and every member of the Corporation, not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the regular Annual Meeting of the Corporation; such notice shall be sufficient, if it is published not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the regular Annual Meeting of the Corporation, in such publication as may be designated by the Board of Directors as the official journal of the corporation. in the following manner: An amendment may be proposed by the Chairman of the Association, a majority of the Governors, or by twenty-five percent (25%) of the Voting Interest of the Association. Copies of proposed amendments shall be included in the notice of any meeting at which a proposed amendment is to be considered or in connection with documentation for action without a meeting. A resolution for the adoption of a proposed amendment may be adopted by a vote of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the Voting Interest of the Association present (in person or by proxy) and voting at a duly noticed meeting at which a quorum is present, or by the written agreement of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the Voting Interest of the Association. Amendments correcting errors, omissions or scrivener's errors may be executed by the officers of the Association, upon Board approval, without need for Association membership vote.
