## PLAN OF COMPLETE LIQUIDATION, DISSOLUTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

- 1. GSH Health, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Corporation"), shall be completely liquidated and dissolved pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as amended (the "Act").
- 2. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation shall be paid and discharged, or adequate provisions shall be made therefor.
- 3. Any assets held by the Corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution, shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.
- 4. After payment of, or making provisions for, all liabilities of the Corporation and after compliance with Section 3 of this Plan, as set forth above, all of the remaining property and assets of the Corporation, if any, of whatsoever kind and character and wherever located, shall be distributed to its sole member, Mid-Florida Medical Services, Inc. This distribution may occur all at once or in a series of payments and may be made in each or in kind and in such manner and at such times as the authorized officers of this Corporation shall in their absolute discretion determine.
- 5. The liquidation and dissolution of the Corporation pursuant to the Plan shall be completed on or before September 30, 2005.
- 6. Charles McPherson, as chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Corporation or any other individual duly authorized by the Corporation shall file with the Florida Department of Stair, as soon as practicable, Articles of Dissolution pursuant to the Act, along with any other forms required by state or federal law.
