- (c.) To provide the Riley home or portions thereof for the use of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP).
- (d.) (c.) To work with, assist, provide space for any charitable, educational, literary, cultural, or civic organization subscribing to the principles and objectives of this Foundation.
