# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

# Doc # 750819

The undersigned authority, acting as President of International Pentecostal City Mission Prayer Center of Florida, Inc. A Florida Non-Profit Corporation and pursuant to Chapter 617. of the Florida statures do hereby adopt the following Articles of Amendments for the Corporation, and would state as follows:

#### **+++** MODIFY ARTICLE II - PURPOSES **+++**

The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United State of Internal Revenue Law. ----

This corporation is a Not-For-Profit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable ----purposes.

#### **\*\*\*** DELETE (B, C, D, E, F) ARTICLE II **\*\*\***

### **###** INSERT ARTICLE VII - ORGANIZATION

A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consit of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

## **\*\*\*MODIFY** ARTICLE VII- Amendments are made by the Board of Directors. **\*\*\*** INSERT ARTICLE IX - CORPORATE ASSETS

B. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, Assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code. \*\*\*\*No members are entitled to vote on this amendment.

This Amendment was adopted by the Board of Directors on August 29, 1998.

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
