## Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation of

### AMERICAN BALLROOM AND CONTEMPORARY DANCE ASSOCIATION OF JACKSONVILLE, INC.

The undersigned hereby certifies that, at a meeting of the members of the corporation held on February 3, 1998, an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of American Ballroom and Contemporary Dance Association of Jacksonville, Inc. were adopted as set forth below. Members of the corporation were entitled to vote on the Amendment, and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

The full text of the Amendment is as follows:

Section 1 of Article VII of the Articles of Incorporation is amended and re-stated to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE VII — BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1: The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors or by an executive committee, as may be provided by the Bylaws, appointed by the Board of Directors. This corporation shall have five directors initially. The number of directors may be increased from time to time by the Bylaws but shall never be less that eight (8) nor more than twenty-five (25).
