## Dear Sir or Madam:

The above referenced taxpayer requested that we contact you regarding the reinstatement of Tower Forum, Inc. It is our understanding that due to the non-filing of the annual report in May 1997, the taxpayer, as a corporate entity, was dissolved. The non-compliance was due to miscommunication between the current director and her predecessor in that the annual report and notice of termination were both addressed to the prior director and consequently not forwarded to the new director.

Upon the Department of State ("Department") making our firm aware of this situation, we immediately contacted the taxpayer and made arrangements to file the appropriate reinstatement forms and comply with the state's regulations. Consequently, we have enclosed a completed Application for Reinstatement for the above referenced taxpayer with \$131.25 which represents payment of \$61.25 for both the 1997 and 1998 annual fees and \$8.75 for the certificate of status.

The Department will make a determination of whether the taxpayer's noncompliance was due to reasonable cause and not to willful negligence, will neglect, or fraud based on the facts and circumstances of the specific case. Based on the facts and circumstances discussed above, the noncompliance was clearly due to reasonable cause and not willful negligence, willful neglect or fraud.

Except for this occurrence, the taxpayer has been in good standing with the Department and has made a prudent effort to be in compliance with all of its filing requirements. We believe the taxpayer's noncompliance was due to reasonable cause or, at most, human error and not willful neglect. Consequently, we respectfully request that the Department waive/abate all reinstatement fees attributable to the non-filing of the annual reports.
