

SECOND AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF:

VILLAS OF BURWICK AND THURSTON HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Articles of Incorporation of the VILLAS OF BURWICK AND THURSTON HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") were filed on June 20, 1980 with the Secretary of State and given Charter Number 753030. A copy of same, certified by the current President and Secretary of the Association to be the original Articles of Incorporation were recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, in Official Records Book 4273, Page 0242.

WHEREAS, a First Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Association was approved by the Board of Directors and the Members of the Association and filed with the Secretary of State on November 16, 2000, and recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida in Official Records Book 4273, Page 0248; and

WHEREAS, a meeting of the Board of Directors was held, with quorum present, on November 6, 2000, at which meeting at least 80% of the Board of Directors did vote to amend the Articles of Incorporation; and at the Annual Meeting of the Members of the Association held on January 15, 2001, with quorum present, at least 80% of the Members present and voting in person or by proxy did vote to amend the Articles of Incorporation all in the various particulars as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, a copy of this Amendment together with a Certificate of Amendment from the Secretary of State and together with a Certification from the President and Secretary of the Association as to the requisite number of votes of the Board of Directors and Unit Owners shall be filed in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Articles of Incorporation of VILLAS OF BURWICK AND THURSTON HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. be and are hereby amended and shall state as provided for herein below, which Amendment shall run with the real property known as the VILLAS OF BURWICK AND THURSTON, and shall be binding on all parties having a right, title or interest in said real property or any part thereof, their heirs, successors, and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of each owner thereof. The following Articles and Paragraphs of the Articles of Incorporation as amended by the First Amendment are further amended as follows: Words <u>Underlined</u> are added and words <u>lined through</u> are deleted. For brevity purposes "..." (3 dots) indicate language intentionally not stated because same is not being changed or amended.

- Article 2. Purposes. Paragraph E. is changed to read as follows:
- E. To provide, purchase, acquire, replace, improve, maintain and/or repair such building structures, landscaping, paving, street lighting and equipment, both real and personal, related to the upkeep, maintenance and appearance of the Community and to the health, safety and welfare of the Members of the Association, as the Board of Directors by majority vote determines necessary and appropriate and/or convenient and which seventy-five (75%) percented the members approve, either by vote at a meeting duly called or in writing.
- Article 4. <u>Voting Rights</u>. is deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in its place.
 - 4. Voting Rights.

Every owner of a Lot shall automatically become a Member of the Association. The Members of the Association will have one vote for each Lot owned. Where more than one person owns an interest in a Lot, all such persons shall be Members of the Association and the vote for such Lot shall be exercised as they, among themselves, determine but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any such Lot.

- Article 7. <u>Directors and Officers</u>. is changed to read as follows:
- Article 7. <u>Directors and Officers</u>.

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary, which officers shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors. The Directors and officers may lawfully and properly exercise the powers set forth in paragraph Article 12 11 hereof. ...

- Article 8. Names of Officers. Delete this Article in its entirety
- Article 9. Board of Directors. now becomes Article 8. Board of Directors.
- Article 10. <u>By-Laws</u>. now becomes Article 9. <u>By-Laws</u>.
- Article 11. Amendment to Articles. now becomes Article 10. Amendment to Articles.
- Article 12. Power. now becomes Article 11. Power.
- Article 12. Power. Paragraph A. is changed to read as follows:
- A. All of the powers set forth and described in Section 617.031 Chapter 617 and 720 of the Florida Statutes.

Article 12. Power. Paragraph B. is changed to read as follows:

B. To acquire and enter into agreements whereby it acquires leaseholds, memberships or other possessory or use interests in lands or facilities including, but not limited to country clubs, golf courses, marinas and other recreational facilities, whether or not contiguous to the lands of the Property intended to provide for the enjoyment, recreation, or other use of benefit of the Unit Owner, provided any such agreement receives the written approval of not less than 51% of the Lot Owners.

Article 13. Indemnification. now becomes Article 12. Indemnification.

All other provisions which are not amended hereby shall remain the same and in full force and effect.
