EXHIBIT "B"

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BAYWOOD CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

Article 3, Section 3.2(g) is hereby amended as follows:

- 3.2 <u>Enumeration</u>. The Association shall have all of the powers and duties set forth in Chapter 718, Florida Statutes (the Condominium Act) except as limited by these Articles and the Declaration and all of the powers and duties reasonably necessary to operate the Condominium pursuant to the Declaration and as it may be amended from time to time, including but not limited to the following:
 - (g) To make and amend reasonable regulations respecting the use and appearance of the property in the condominium; provided, however, that all those regulations and amendments thereto shall be approved by not less than 51% of the votes of the entire membership of the Association before they shall become effective.

Article 4, Section 4.1 is hereby amended as follows:

4.1 <u>Membership.</u> The members of the Association shall consist of all of the record owners of the condominium units in Baywood Northwest Condominium and future condominiums, if constructed and developed as hereinbefore set forth, and after termination of the condominiums shall consist of those who are members at the time of the termination and their successors and assigns.

Article 5, Section 5.1 is hereby amended as follows:

5.1 <u>Number and qualification</u>. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a board consisting of the number of directors determined by the Bylaws, but not less than three directors, and in the absence of that determination shall consist of three directors. Directors must need not be members of the Association.

Article 9, Section 9.2 is hereby amended as follows:
