Minutes of the Annual Meeting Markham Place Homeowners Association, Inc.

February 26, 2006

The annual meeting for the Markham Place Homeowners Association, Inc. was held at the home of Chas and Nancy Schmitt, 151 Archers Point, Longwood, FL on Sunday, February 26, 2006.

Call to Order

President, Dave Carley, called the meting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Those homeowners in attendance included: Steve and Sandi Graham, Linda Schoonover and Dave Carley, Jon and Cynthia Martin, Glenn Brunskill and Michael Yackwak, Tom and Mary Kuchma, Rick and Sara Monahan, Joyce Sudeall, Jim and Loretta DiSalvatore, Merle and Linda Flandermeyer, Hank Kaczowka, Peg Martin and Scott Boodman, Chas and Nancy Schmitt, Joseph Webster, Bill and Karen Laffredi, and John Higgins. Those unable to attend but willing to give the board their proxys were: Robert and Yvonne Clemments, Earl and Kathi Hodil, Bill and Nelli Smith, Pam Hale, and Scott and Susie Plakon.

Officers Reports

Nancy Schmitt, Secretary, distributed minutes from the last annual meeting. Following review, Linda Schoonover moved that the minutes be approved. Rick Monahan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Karen Laffredi, Treasurer, distributed the treasurer's report and the Projected 2006 budget. Following review and discussion, Steve Graham moved to accept both reports. Chas Schmitt seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously passed by the membership.


Tom Kuchma, Architectural Review Committee Chairman, reported the committee has reviewed plans for the home to be built by developer, Charles Ayres on Hunters Trail. Tom also relayed that the ARC has had positive communication regarding requests to have the architecture of the home blend well with existing homes and has been effective in making our Declaration of Restrictions an important part of this lot development.

Old Business

President, Dave Carley reported:

- a.) The Third Amendment to the Declaration of Restrictions was approved by 80% of homeowners as stated in the by-laws and has been filed with Seminole County by Vice President, John Higgins. Current complete copies of the Declarations of Restrictions and By-Laws are available on request from the secretary.
- b.) Maintenance repairs made this year include repainting the street and stop signs, pressure washing the entrance walls and repainting the fence along Markham Woods Road, and repairing the fence following an accident.

- c.) A "No Soliciting" sign is in the process of being purchased to place on one of the brick entrance columns. This will discourage solicitors and give the homeowners some recourse if solicitors come into the neighborhood.
- d.) The ARC has been effective this year in researching info on two homes in foreclosure and communicating with homeowners regarding improvements and concerns.
- e.) E-mail communication has provided positive communication for notices and concerns. Each homeowner that can be reached this way is encouraged to provide an e-mail address for the secretary.

New Business

A. Proposed Dues Increase

Treasurer, Karen Laffredi, presented the proposed dues increase necessary to cover cost of living increases and build a contingency fund for unexpected future expenses. Karen reviewed expenses versus income over the past several years and related information to the 2006 proposed budget. Chas Schmitt moved that the annual homeowners dues be raised \$50, making the annual homeowners dues \$200 per year beginning in 2007. This increase will cover cost of living increase and also provide contingency funds to cover unexpected minor expenses. Sandi Graham seconded the motion. Following discussion, including comparison of our dues to other neighborhoods, it was determined that the dues increase is necessary to cover future expenses and the motion was unanimously carried.

B. Proposed Insurance Coverage

Vice-President, John Higgins, presented information regarding insurance coverage for the Markham Place Homeowners Association, Inc. Chas Schmitt moved to approve up to \$4000.00 in the budget for insurance. Steve Graham seconded the motion. Following discussion, it was decided that the Board will continue to study three (3) kinds of insurance in 2006; these being, General Liability Insurance of \$2,000,000 for common Markham Place general risk exposures; Professional Liability Insurance of \$2,000,000. and Property & Casualty Insurance for our common property with an estimated market value of \$75,000. If the Board finds such coverage and the total combined premiums for such insurances is \$4000 or less on an annualized basis, then the Board will purchase it and fund the 2006 pro-rated premiums out of 2006 running budget surplus. Also, if the Board finds such coverage in 2006 and purchases it, the dues for owners will be increased beginning in 2007 by as much as \$125.00 per owner (based on an estimated 35 paying owners.) This dues increase will be proportionately lower if the insurance premiums turn out to be lower than \$4,000.00 annualized. If the Board cannot find insurance coverage with combined total premiums of \$4000.00 or less, then it will not contract for such insurance, but will call a special membership meeting in 2006 to discuss the whole insurance issue further.

An insurance committee, consisting of John Higgins, Joe Webster, Loretta DiSalvatore, Merle Flandermeyer and Steve Graham, will continue further research to locate the best insurance coverage and report back to the Board of Directors.
