AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY OPTOMETRIC SOCIETY, INC. A Not For Profit Corporation

The undersigned as President of the Palm Beach County Optometric Society, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation, hereby certifies that pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1002, Florida Statutes, (Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act), the undersigned corporation, pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by its Board of Directors on March 4, 1998, and approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of its membership (the number of votes cast being sufficient for approval) in attendance at a meeting on March 11, 1998, hereby adopts the following Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation:

New Article XIII is added and reads as set forth:

ARTICLE XIII DISPOSITION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to an organization who has the same or similar corporate purposes as those of the corporation and who maintains an exemption under Section 501 (c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

Alternatively, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
