## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ST. ANDREWS COUNTRY CLUB a Florida not-for-profit corporation

THE UNDERSIGNED, President of ST. ANDREWS COUNTRY CLUB, a Florida not-for-profit corporation organized under ch. 617, Florida Statutes, the Articles of Incorporation of which were filed with the Florida Department of State on September 29, 1982, hereby amends said Certificate of Incorporation, pursuant to Article 617.1006 of the Florida Statutes as follows:

I. AMENDMENT 1 - Article VIII is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Club shall have no more than fifteen (15) members on its Board of Governors. The number of members of the Board of Governors will be determined by the By-Laws

II. AMENDMENT 2 - Article XIV is hereby amended to read:

## **GOLF AND TENNIS MEMBERS**

The Club shall have a maximum of six hundred thirteen (613) golf members and seventy-five (75) tennis members and one (1) charter member, as described in ARTICLE XV flexeof.

Golf and tennis membership will be offered only to owners of homes or lots in St. Andrews Country Club. The Club shall have the right to repurchase all of the memberships previously issued to non-residents of St. Andrews Country Club on a last-in first-out basis, and if the Club exercises that right, the non-resident member will be entitled to be paid the grater of (a) the Equity membership contribution currently charged for his category of membership, or (b) the membership contribution actually paid by such member for his membership.

Amendment 1 was passed by the Members by a vote of 680 for and 64 against on February 3, 1997. Amendment 2 was passed by the Members by a vote of 558 for and 157 against on March 29, 1998.

The execution of this Certificate by the undersigned constitutes an affirmation that the facts stated herein are true.
