Dear Secretary Mortham,


We are a small chapter of the Audubon Society and have fallen behind in paying our annual report fee.

We had a turnover in officers and this, particularly the introduction of a new treasurer disturbed the continuity of our chapter affairs so that we overlooked the proper time to submit this check. This has never happened before.

Missing paying the annual report fee is causing us to be penalized one hundred seventy-five dollars. We are a small provincial group, not a corporation. To penalize us this much will wipe out our treasury and require an assessment of the members, a hardship for many of us.

To bring things up to date we are enclosing a check for \$61.25, our basic obligation for 1997 that should have been paid in the spring of this year. We hope that the reinstatement fee can be waived.
